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We will be making the Rainbow quilt over the 31 days of May. 154 blocks HST - 6 HST a day for 15 days and 4 HST a day for 16 of the days Starting Violet in the upper left and ending with Red in the lower right.

# Supply List and Cutting Directions

Light fabric for background and inner border. 2 2/3 fabric - You can also do the lights scrappy - Cut 77 squares 5" x 5" for HST (HST - Half Square Triangle) - cut 2 outer border strips 2" x 47.5" - cut 2 outer border strips 2" x 55.5"

#### **Border Fabric**

1 2/3 yd for a border cut on length of fabric with no piecing
cut 2 inner border strips 3.5" x 59.5"
cut 2 inner border strips 3.5" x 53.5"

### Red fabrics - 1/3 yd

– Cut 8 squares 5" x 5" for HST (HST - Half Square Triangle)


**Orange fabrics - 1/3 yd** - Cut 11 squares 5" x 5" for HST (HST - Half Square Triangle)

**Yellow fabrics - 1/3 yd** - Cut 15 squares 5" x 5" for HST (HST - Half Square Triangle)

**Blue fabrics -1/3 yd** - Cut 14 squares 5" x 5" for HST (HST - Half Square Triangle)



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When making the Triangles scrappy, the yardage is the total needed.

**Green fabrics - 1/2 yd** - Cut 17 squares 5" x 5" for HST (HST - Half Square Triangle)

Indigo fabrics - 1/3 yd – Cut 9 squares 5" x 5" for HST (HST - Half Square Triangle)

Violet fabrics -¼ yd – Cut 5 squares 5" x 5" for HST (HST - Half Square Triangle)

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### **Directions**

1) Using the 5" light and 5" rainbow color fabric squares make HSTs using method on the last page trim to 4.5" square


Red Squares - Make 15 units Orange squares - Make 21 units Yellow squares - Make 30 units Green squares - Make 33 units Blue squares - Make 27 units Indigo squares - Make 18 units Violet squares - Make 10 units

2) We will start with Red in the upper left and end with Violet in the lower right Sewing 6 or 4 HST per day.

Following the diagram, sew the HST units in sections. Measures 44.5" x 56.5"



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


Step 1

- Draw a line on the back of all the lighter squares




Step 2

- Layer the 2 squares
- Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both
- Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST



Step 4

-Trim squares to size needed using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
