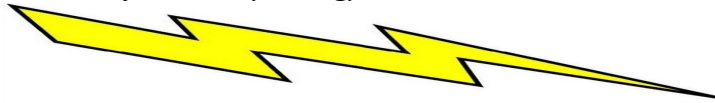

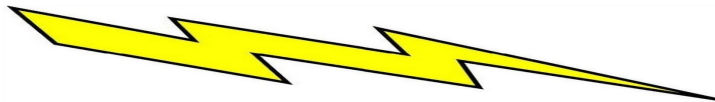
There are a plethora of books available on Greek Mythology. A few are listed below. To locate additional print resources use the Destiny Online Catalog.

-Reviews the epic stories of Greek mythology.



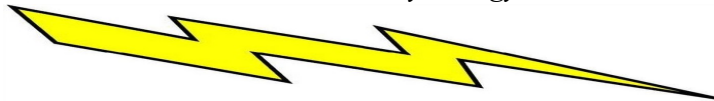
