Today is I am sharing my Peony Thank You Card that I made for a swap using the beautiful Peony Garden Suite Collection. I love peonies and when I saw this collection, I knew that I had to buy it! It is getting lots of love! So far, I have made 4 cards with it! I am sharing two of those cards here.



For my card, I pulled out my Stampin' Up! Blends in Petal Pink and Old Olive to colour this gorgeous flower. I love how you can use the matching dies to cut out the blooms, but there are also dies that build a 3D peony bloom as well! I made the card below for my Mom's 75th birthday using the 3D bloom and it was gorgeous!





I love the softness of the Peony Garden Designer Series Paper and that was from where I pulled my colour scheme of Petal Pink and Gray Granite with a touch of Old Olive.



I used the pretty Dainty Diamonds 3D Embossing Folder on the Petal Pink card stock. For embellishments, I used the Gray Granite Ribbon, a Square Vellum Doily and a scattering of Elegant Faceted Gems.

Stamps/Bundles/Dies: Prized Peony Bundle (154056), Stitched Rectangles Dies (151820)

Inks: Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad (132708), Old Olive Classic Stampin' Pad (147090)

Paper: Gray Granite (146983), Petal Pink (146985), Basic White (159276), Peony Garden Designer Series Paper (152483)

Accessories: Dainty Diamonds 3D Embossing Folder (152702), Old Olive Stampin' Blends Combo Pack (154892), Petal Pink Stampin' Blends Combo Pack (154893), Gray Granite Ribbon (152463), Elegant Faceted Gems (152464), Square Vellum Doilies (152484), Bone Folder (102300), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Stampin' Seal (152813), Glue Dots (103683)



Measurements:

- Gray Granite: 5 ½" x 8 ½" scored at 4 ¼"
- Petal Pink: 5 ¼" x 4"
- Basic White: 2 pieces
 - 23/8" x 1" (sentiment)
 - o 2 3/4" x 3 1/2"
- Peony Garden Designer Series Paper: 3 pieces at 3 ¼" x 1 ¼"
- Gray Granite Ribbon: 2"
