

#### Taking a Photo

Now you know all of the controls you need to take a photo. Let's give it a shot! Follow along with the steps on your own camera. Take a photo of anything around you!



Press the On/Off Button to turn the camera **ON.** 



2 Rotate the Mode Dial to AUTO. Align the icon with the marker.




Point the camera at a subject. Hold it firmly.



Use the display to frame the image you want.



Focus the image by pressing lightly on the shutter button.




To take the photo, press the **shutter button** down the rest of the way.

#### **Viewing Photos**

You took your first photo! Follow along with these steps to see the photo you took on your camera's display.







View your photo on the LCD display. It looks great!



Press the **shutter button** to exit review mode.

## 4 Using Zoom

The zoom feature is one of the easiest ways to control the appearance of your photo.


#### **Zoom Out**



By zooming out, you can include more of the scene or surroundings in your photo.

Shift the zoom control left to zoom out.

#### **Zoom In**




By zooming in, you can center the photo on a specific object or person and cut out the surroundings.

Shift the zoom control right to zoom in.

Try it now! Zoom in or out, then take another photo.

#### **Using Flash**

If you're shooting at night or in dim lighting, you may want to use flash. The flash will go off when you take the photo to illuminate your surroundings.



Toggle the **flash switch** left to raise the flash; it will slide out of the top of the camera. Don't block it with your fingers! To lower the flash, push it down with your finger.

Try it now. Turn off the lights if you can, and take a photo with the flash on!



#### **Viewing Multiple Photos**

Now that you've had a chance to take a few photos, you can use the review feature to look back through them all. Click on each numbered step to learn how.

#### **Reviewing Multiple Photos**


Now that you've had a chance to take a few photos, you can use the review feature to look back through them all. Click on each numbered step to learn how.



Click on the **Review** button again. You will see the most recent photo you took.

#### **Reviewing Multiple Photos**

Now that you've had a chance to take a few photos, you can use the review feature to look back through them all. Click on each numbered step to learn how.



- Click on the **Review** button again. You will see the most recent photo you took.
- Press on the *left* of the **Selector Button** to a previous photo. Continue pressing left to move *back* through your photos.
- Press on the *right* of the **Selector Button** to return to a more recent photo. Continue pressing right to move *forward*.
- Click the **shutter button** to exit review mode and take more photos.

Try it now! Look back through your photos.
