Piano Proficiency Requirements

The Piano Proficiency is a graduation requirement for all music majors with the exception of Piano and Organ majors. It music be completed in order for students to enter Junior-Level Theory courses. It is recommended that students complete the Piano Proficiency at the end of their Sophomore Year. It is also recommended that students enroll in Class Piano until they have successfully completed the Piano Proficiency.

- **I. Repertoire**: Students may choose from the list of Repertoire on Pg. 2 or submit a piece of their own choosing to the faculty for approval.
- II. Transposition: Candidates will be given a short excerpt to transpose into a given key.
 The excerpt will be made available one week prior to the exam.
- **III. Scales:** All major and parallel harmonic minor scales, two octaves, hands together. See scale fingering chart (page 3).
- IV. Chord Progression: $I IV I_6^6 V^7 I$ in all keys, major and minor. See chord progression chart (pages 4 and 5).
- V. Melody Harmonization: Candidates must harmonize a melody using I,IV, V7 chords. The melody is to be played in the RH while playing block chords or a suitable accompaniment pattern in the LH. The Harmonization excerpt will be made available one week prior to the exam.
- VI. Sight-reading: Sight-reading of a selected work at the intermediate level. Pieces for this portion of the Piano Proficiency will be made available 30 minutes prior to the exam.
- VII. Improvisation: An improvisation over one of the following chord progressions.

 Candidates should improvise a melody in the RH while playing block chords or a chordal accompaniment in the LH. The student will play the chord progression twice in a key of their choosing:

1.
$$I - vi - IV - ii - V - vi - ii - V - I$$

2.
$$I - vi - IV - V - I - IV - V - I$$
