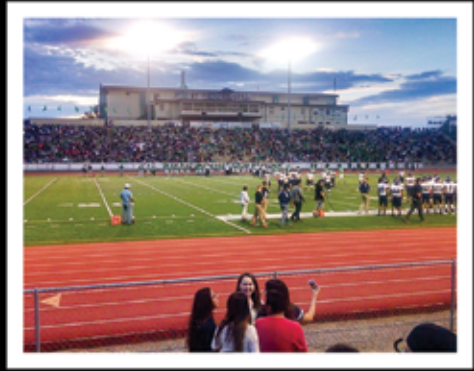

A MESSAGE FROM PRINCIPAL GOLDEN


Dear Panther Football Fans:
