#### Two Thoughts: "Life Changing!" and "What are you going to do about it?"

The first two Walks of the year were awesome events that touched Pilgrims in powerful ways. The first gathering, at Lake Houston UMC, was incredible, and featured a fourth day testimony that was absolutely phenomenal – amazingly powerful, personal and moving. The Women's Summer Walk #104 is rapidly approaching and training is already in progress. Team selection has already occurred for the Men's and Women's Fall Walks and calls are being made to fill the teams. With that much done it's easy to get complacent and think that there is nothing left to do – but the most important role has not been filled yet, and consider this my personal invitation for you to fill that role – Pilgrim Sponsor.

In reading the Walk to Emmaus story, remember that the two disciples who walked with Jesus on the road to Emmaus, once their eyes were opened, RAN to tell the good news. They could not contain their joy. Recently we had a booth providing information to Texas Annual Conference attendees. Practically all of the people who stopped at the booth who had been on a Walk used the same two words to describe their experience – Life Changing! Was your Walk life changing? In what ways has your life changed? More importantly..."what are you going to do about it?"

The role of Emmaus is to equip disciples so that they can go out into the world and serve God as they are led by the Holy Spirit. This manifests itself in a plethora of ways: leadership roles in your home church (this should be a part for every member of the 4<sup>th</sup> Day, even if they serve in other ways); serving through Kairos, Chrysalis, or another 4<sup>th</sup> Day program; individual discipleship at work, or in your community; just to mention the most common. The Houston North Emmaus Community currently needs volunteers, so if you are looking for a place to serve, please consider helping our Community.

I talk to people all the time who tell me they went on their Walk, but haven't been involved since "because they have not been asked to help." Well, here are just a few of the many ways where we can use YOUR help:

## \*\*\*A Special Note from Communications\*\*\*

HNEC is using a third party email system (iContact) during the changeover to The Upper Room's new membership management system, which does not currently have email capability. So...anything you see about HNEC from iContact is not spam...it is the only way for now that we can communicate with the community as a whole.

As the new membership management system comes on line, you should receive an email from **The Upper Room asking you to go to the new membership portal to register and verify your information. Please do so** as it will be the method used for communications and membership management once the full system is online. Having your correct information will ensure that you can remain an active and informed part of our community in the future.

If you did not receive an email from The Upper Room or have misplaced yours before verifying your information in the Ministry Manager, go to this URL: <a href="https://ministrymanager.upperroom.org/">https://ministrymanager.upperroom.org/</a> and click the **Sign Up** button. Fill out the form that is presented and if you get in, please verify all of your personal information (Home phone and birthdate are mandatory fields and must be entered or all other changes will be rejected) and click **Save** in the lower right corner. If you are told that your email is already taken, it is probably because both you and your spouse used the same email in our old iNet system. Ministry Manager requires a discrete email address for every member, so if you had a common email address, one of you was automatically assigned a "dummy" Ministry Manager email address to satisfy this need. Have the other spouse log in and complete their registration and then contact <a href="mailto:communicationss@hnec.org">communicationss@hnec.org</a> to obtain your "dummy" email address so you then can use that to register and then log in and change it to a real email address.

Although it is inconvenient, it is important that you maintain your email address up-to-date in both the Ministry Manager system and in iContact so you will receive HNEC communications now (via iContact) and in the future (when bulk email is enabled in Ministry Manager).

Team Selection again thanks you so much for your willingness to serve. If you would like to serve on a team, please let us know if you have not already done so. You may register your desire to serve on a team by going to the HNEC website, and selecting "Team Service" under Fourth Day Community on the Left side. Read through if you have any questions and then look for the "Team Service Interest" link which will take you to the page to actually notify Team Selection of your interest.

Names that are submitted through the website or any Fourth Day activity are brought to each Team Selection meeting to be considered for appropriate positions.

Please help us honor your offering of service if you presented your name this year but did not get a call to work a walk. Please re-submit your name and give us a note that you submitted your name but did not receive a call. We will try and give you priority for next year.

Please also help us to spread the word among our clergy! Remind them how the walk to Emmaus has deepened your faith and prompted you to serve in your local church. Encourage them to talk to the congregation about the Walk to Emmaus opportunity and, if appropriate, ask if they would be willing to serve as a clergy for a day or for the weekend.
