MISSION

EASTER PROCLAMATION (Exsultet)

1) Rejoice, heavenly powers! Sing, choirs of angels! Exult, all creation around God's throne! Jesus Christ, our King, is risen! Sound the trumpet of salvation!

- 2) This is the night when Christians everywhere, washed clean of sin and freed from all defilement, are restored to grace and grow together in holiness.
- 1) This is the night when Jesus Christ broke the chains of death and rose triumphant from the grave.
- **2)** What good would life have been to us, had Christ not come as our Redeemer?
- 1) Father, how wonderful Your care for us! How boundless Your merciful love! To ransom a slave, You gave away Your Son.
- 2) The power of this holy night dispels all evil, washes guilt away, restores, lost innocence, brings mourners joy. It casts out hatred, brings us peace, and humbles earthly pride.
- **1)** Therefore, heavenly Father, in the joy of this moment receive our sacrifice of praise, Your Church's solemn offering.
- 2) Christ, that Morning Star, let Your light mingle with the light of heaven, shed Your peaceful light on all.

All: Ant. 2: "Were not our hearts burning within us while He spoke to us on the way and opened the scriptures to us?"

Leader: Risen Lord, help us to rise with You as we begin this day. Grant us the grace to see Your victory in our prayer and sacrifice. May all our aches and pains be a share in the suffering of others. As we take up our cross, may we help all carry theirs. Help us to enter their suffering for a while as we walk with You. Help us to support each other in hope.

CONSTRUCTION ZONE (Col. 3:5–17)

Leader: Ant. 3: "Everyone must decide whether they will walk in creative sacrifice or the darkness of destructive selfishness. This is the judgment. Life's most persistent and urgent question is, 'What are you doing for others?'" (Martin Luther King Jr.)

- 1) Put to death whatever in you is earthly: fornication, impurity, obsession, evil desire and greed.
- 2) These are the ways you also once followed, when you were living that life. But now you must get rid of all such things: anger, rage, cruelty, defamation, and abusive language from your mouth.

- 1) Do not lie to one another, seeing that you have stripped off the old self with its practices and have clothed yourselves with the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge, according to the image of its Creator.
- 2) In that renewal there is no longer Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, slave and free; but Christ is all and in all.
- 1) As God's holy and beloved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience. Put up with one another, and if anyone has a complaint against another, forgive each other; just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you must also do.
- 2) Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony. And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, the peace into which you also were called in one body. And be thankful.
- 1) Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, as in all wisdom you teach and admonish one another, singing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God.

2) And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

- God, what could separate me from Your love? Not a failed test, or a broken promise, or a hurtful word.
- **2)** What could tear You from me? Not the lure of power, or immediate gratification, or unnatural highs.
- 1) If You, God, are on my side, who could be against me? Not a vengeful peer, or an uncaring person, or someone whose relationship with me has gone disagreeable.
- 2) What situation could divide You and me, God? Not depression over a loss, or anger over being laughed at, or guilt from being caught redhanded.

- 1) No, in all these things, I know that I am never alone. Because You, God, conquered sin, despair, and even death itself through Your endless love, a love that showed itself through Your Son.
- 2) I am convinced, Lord, that nothing, absolutely nothing, will ever separate me from Your love... ever! *Amen.*

- 2) "Your way of acting should be different from the world's way; the love of Christ must come before all else. You must relieve the fate of the poor, clothe the naked, visit the sick, and bury the dead. Go to help the troubled and console the sorrowing." (St. Benedict)

Leader: Ant. 3: "Gratitude, all that matters: that we can bow, take a deep bow. Just that. Just that." (*Br. David Steindl-Rast, OSB*)

- 1) "Then He took the seven loaves and the fish, gave thanks, broke the loaves, and gave them to the disciples, who, in turn, gave them to the crowds." (Matthew 15:36)
- 2) So they took away the stone. And Jesus raised His eyes and said, "Father, I thank You for hearing Me. I know that You always hear Me... that they may believe that You sent Me." He cried out in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out!" (John 11: 41)

- 1) For I received from the Lord what I also handed on to you, that the Lord Jesus, on the night he was handed over, took bread and, after He had given thanks, broke it and said, "This is My body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of Me." (1 Cor. 11:24)
- 2) Then He took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, and they all drank from it. He said to them, "This is My blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many." (Mark 14:23)

First Apparition: Our Lady of Guadalupe appears to St. Juan Diego. Our Lady requests a temple in her honor.

Pray Our Father...

Meditation: Our Lady of Guadalupe, my Queen and my Mother, I thank you for your first apparition to St. Juan Diego when you revealed that you are the Most Pure Virgin, Mary, Mother of the true God and Mother of the human family. I thank you for requesting a temple to be built where you stood, to bear witness to your love, your compassion, your aid, and your protection for all who would love you, trust you, and invoke your help.

Pray three Hail Marys and one Glory be...

Second Apparition: Our Lady of Guadalupe gives St. Juan Diego encouragement after his return from the Bishop's home.

Pray **Our Father**...

Meditation: Our Lady of Guadalupe, my Queen and my Mother, I thank you for your second apparition to St. Juan Diego when upon his return from the Bishop's house, he knelt in humiliation and defeat before you since he was unable to accomplish your mission. I thank you for the courage and encouragement you gave to St. Juan Diego to make a second appeal to the Bishop.

Pray three Hail Marys and one Glory be...

Third Apparition: Our Lady of Guadalupe promised a sign to St. Juan Diego for the Bishop.

Pray Our Father...

Meditation: Our Lady of Guadalupe, My Queen and my Mother, I thank you for your third apparition to St. Juan Diego when, after this unsuccessful attempt to have a temple built, you said to him, "So be it, son. Return tomorrow in order that you may secure for the Bishop, the sign for which he has asked. When this is in your possession he will believe you. He will no longer doubt your word and suspect your good faith. Be assured that I shall reward you for all that you have undergone."

Pray three Hail Marys and one Glory be...

Fourth Apparition: Our Lady of Guadalupe fulfills her promise by showing herself on the tilma of St. Juan Diego.

Pray Our Father...

Meditation: Our Lady of Guadalupe, my Queen and my Mother. I thank you for your fourth apparition to St. Juan Diego when you ordered him to pick the roses he would find on the summit of the hill and bring them to you. I thank you for arranging them in his tilma when you said, "This cluster of roses is

the sign that you shall take to the Bishop. You are to tell him, in my name, that in this he will recognize my will and that he must fulfill it. You will be my ambassador, wholly worthy of my confidence. Only in the presence of the Bishop shall you unfold your mantle and disclose that which you carry." I thank you for your image printed on the tilma, which appeared when the roses were released."

8TH STATION: JESUS MEETS THE WOMEN OF JERUSALEM.

All: "If anyone wishes to come after Me, they must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow Me."

Reader: "I was sick and you cared for Me, in prison and you visited Me." (Matthew 25: 36)

All: "Do not be afraid." "Not my will but Yours be done." Our Father ...

9TH STATION: JESUS FALLS FOR THE THIRD TIME.

All: "If anyone wishes to come after Me, they must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow Me."

Reader: "Woe to you hypocrites, woe to you blind guides, blind fools. You cleanse the outside of the cup and dish, but inside they are full of plunder and self-indulgence." (Matthew 23: 1 – 15)

All: Father forgive me for being so full of myself, and allowing my power to be felt.
Our Father...

Sing: "Jesus Remember Me"

10TH STATION: JESUS IS STRIPPED OF HIS GARMENTS.

All: "If anyone wishes to come after Me, they must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow Me."

Reader: "I was naked and you clothed Me." (Matthew 25: 36)

All: "Do not be afraid." "Not my will but Yours be done." Our Father...

11TH STATION: JESUS IS NAILED TO THE CROSS.

All: "If anyone wishes to come after Me, they must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow Me."

Reader: "Can you drink the chalice that I am going to drink?" (Matthew 20: 22)

All: "Do not be afraid." "Not my will but Yours be done." Our Father...

Sing: "Jesus Remember Me."

12TH STATION: JESUS DIES ON THE CROSS.

All: "If anyone wishes to come after Me, they must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow Me."

Reader: "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends." (John 15: 13)

All: "Do not be afraid." "Not my will but Yours be done." Our Father...

Sing: "Jesus Remember Me"

13TH STATION: JESUS IS TAKEN DOWN FROM THE CROSS.

All: "If anyone wishes to come after Me, they must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow Me." **Reader:** "Blessed are they who mourn, for they will be comforted." (*Matthew 5: 4*)

All: "Do not be afraid." "Not my will but Yours be done." Our Father...

Sing: "Jesus Remember Me"

14TH STATION: JESUS IS LAID IN THE TOMB.

All: "If anyone wishes to come after Me, they must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow Me."

Reader: "It was not you who chose Me, but I who chose you, and appointed you to go and bear fruit that will remain, so that whatever you ask the Father in My name, He may give you. This I command you: love one another." (John 15:16)

All: "Do not be afraid." "Not my will but Yours be done." Our Father...

Sing: "Jesus Remember Me"

Leader: (Kneel or bow your heads.) "Lord, send down our abundant blessing upon Your people who have devoutly recalled the death of Your Son in the sure hope of the resurrection. Grant them mercy, bring them comfort. May their faith grow stronger and their eternal salvation be assured. We ask this through Christ our Lord. **Amen.** (Good Friday Blessing)

CHAPLET OF THE DIVINE MERCY

(Use common rosary.)

Make the *Sign of the Cross*.

Opening Prayer: You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

(On the **Large Bead** before each of the five decades) Eternal Father I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

(On the 10 **small beads** of each decade)
For the sake of His sorrowful passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

(Conclude with Holy God, repeating three times)
Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have
mercy on us and on the whole world.

Closing Prayer: Eternal God, in whom Mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion

inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is love and mercy itself. *Amen.*

PRAYERS OF THE ROSARY How to Pray the Rosary

- **1.** Make the Sign of the Cross. Holding the Crucifix, say the *Apostles' Creed*.
- **2.** On the first large bead, say an *Our Father*.
- **3.** Say three *Hail Marys* on each of the next three small beads for the increase in the virtues of faith, hope and charity.
- 4. Say the Glory Be.
- **5.** For each of the five decades, announce the Mystery, recite the prayer after the Mystery, and then say the *Our Father*.
- **6.** While fingering each of the 10 beads of the decade, next say 10 Hail Marys while meditating on the Mystery. Then say a Glory Be and the Fatima prayer.
- After saying the five decades, say the Hail, Holy Oueen.

Fifth Sorrowful Mystery: Jesus Dies on the Cross "Ecce Homo: the meaning, the origin and fulfillment of humanity is to be found in Christ, the God who humbles Himself out of love, even unto death, death on a Cross."

Prayer: Period of Silent Contemplation.

First Glorious Mystery: Resurrection of Jesus, the Christ Prayer: "Father, let the contemplation of this mystery raise us up and renew our lives by the Spirit that is within us." Amen.

Second Glorious Mystery: *The Christ Ascends into Heaven*Prayer: "Father in heaven, our minds were prepared for the coming of Your kingdom when You took Christ beyond our sight so that we might seek Him in His glory." *Amen.*

Third Glorious Mystery: *Pentecost*Prayer: "Almighty and ever-living God, may the Spirit unite all on Earth to proclaim Your glory." *Amen.*

Fourth Glorious Mystery: *The Assumption of Mary* Prayer: "Father, in Heaven, may we follow the example of Mary in reflecting Your holiness." *Amen.*

Fifth Glorious Mystery: *The Crowning of Mary* Prayer: "Father may we come to share in the glory of Your children in the kingdom of Heaven." *Amen.*
