- 2) But it is You, my own companion, my intimate friend! How close was the friendship between us? We walked together in harmony in the house of God. *(Psalm 55)*

- 1) Though we stumble we shall never fall, for the Lord holds us by the hand. *(Psalm 37)*

Leader: God our Creator, in the silent darkness of this new day You fill us with Your breath, to sing songs of hope. Transform our fear into joy. Provide us with courage to walk in Your presence and listen to Your call. Help us to live in true joy. Nourish Your presence of hope and peace even when things become difficult. EASTER PROCLAMATION (Exsultet)

Leader: Ant. 2: “Were not our hearts burning within us while He spoke to us on the way and opened the scriptures to us?” *(Luke 24:32)*

- 1)** Rejoice, heavenly powers! Sing, choirs of angels! Exult, all creation around God’s throne! Jesus Christ, our King, is risen! Sound the trumpet of salvation!

2) This is the night when Christians everywhere, washed clean of sin and freed from all defilement, are restored to grace and grow together in holiness.

1) This is the night when Jesus Christ broke the chains of death and rose triumphant from the grave.

2) What good would life have been to us, had Christ not come as our Redeemer?

1) Father, how wonderful Your care for us! How boundless Your merciful love! To ransom a slave, You gave away Your Son.

2) The power of this holy night dispels all evil, washes guilt away, restores, lost innocence, brings mourners joy. It casts out hatred, brings us peace, and humbles earthly pride.

1) Therefore, heavenly Father, in the joy of this moment receive our sacrifice of praise, Your Church's solemn offering.

2) Christ, that Morning Star, let Your light mingle with the light of heaven, shed Your peaceful light on all.

All: Ant. 2: *“Were not our hearts burning within us while He spoke to us on the way and opened the scriptures to us?”*

Leader: Risen Lord, help us to rise with You as we begin this day. Grant us the grace to see Your victory in our prayer and sacrifice. May all our aches and pains be a share in the suffering of others. As we take up our cross, may we help all carry theirs. Help us to enter their suffering for a while as we walk with You. Help us to support each other in hope.

All: *Amen*

CONSTRUCTION ZONE (*Col. 3:5–17*)

Leader: Ant. 3: “Everyone must decide whether they will walk in creative sacrifice or the darkness of destructive selfishness. This is the judgment. Life’s most persistent and urgent question is, ‘What are you doing for others?’” (*Martin Luther King Jr.*)

- 1)** Put to death whatever in you is earthly: fornication, impurity, obsession, evil desire and greed.
- 2)** These are the ways you also once followed, when you were living that life. But now you must get rid of all such things: anger, rage, cruelty, defamation, and abusive language from your mouth.

-
- 1) Do not lie to one another, seeing that you have stripped off the old self with its practices and have clothed yourselves with the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge, according to the image of its Creator.
 - 2) In that renewal there is no longer Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, slave and free; but Christ is all and in all.

-
- 1) As God's holy and beloved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience. Put up with one another, and if anyone has a complaint against another, forgive each other; just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you must also do.
 - 2) Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony. And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, the peace into which you also were called in one body. And be thankful.

-
- 1) Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, as in all wisdom you teach and admonish one another, singing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God.

- 2) And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

All: *Glory be to the Father...*

All: Ant. 3: *“Everyone must decide whether they will walk in creative sacrifice or the darkness of destructive selfishness. This is the judgment. Life’s most persistent and urgent question is, ‘what are you doing for others?’”*

- 2) I am convinced, Lord, that nothing, absolutely nothing, will ever separate me from Your love... ever! *Amen.*

Meditation: Our Lady of Guadalupe, my Queen and my Mother, I thank you for your second apparition to St. Juan Diego when upon his return from the Bishop's house, he knelt in humiliation and defeat before you since he was unable to accomplish your mission. I thank you for the courage and encouragement you gave to St. Juan Diego to make a second appeal to the Bishop.

*Pray three **Hail Marys** and one **Glory be...***

Third Apparition: Our Lady of Guadalupe promised a sign to St. Juan Diego for the Bishop.

*Pray **Our Father**...*

Meditation: Our Lady of Guadalupe, My Queen and my Mother, I thank you for your third apparition to St. Juan Diego when, after this unsuccessful attempt to have a temple built, you said to him, "So be it, son. Return tomorrow in order that you may secure for the Bishop, the sign for which he has asked. When this is in your possession he will believe you. He will no longer doubt your word and suspect your good faith. Be assured that I shall reward you for all that you have undergone."

*Pray three **Hail Marys** and one **Glory be**...*

Fourth Apparition: Our Lady of Guadalupe fulfills her promise by showing herself on the tilma of St. Juan Diego.

*Pray **Our Father**...*

Meditation: Our Lady of Guadalupe, my Queen and my Mother. I thank you for your fourth apparition to St. Juan Diego when you ordered him to pick the roses he would find on the summit of the hill and bring them to you. I thank you for arranging them in his tilma when you said, "This cluster of roses is

the sign that you shall take to the Bishop. You are to tell him, in my name, that in this he will recognize my will and that he must fulfill it. You will be my ambassador, wholly worthy of my confidence. Only in the presence of the Bishop shall you unfold your mantle and disclose that which you carry.” I thank you for your image printed on the tilma, which appeared when the roses were released.”

*Pray three **Hail Marys** and one **Glory be...***

Remember, O most gracious Virgin of Guadalupe, that in the celestial apparition on the Mount of Tepeyac, you did promise to show your compassion and pity towards all who, loving and trusting you, seek your help and call upon you in our necessity and afflictions, also to listen to our prayers, to dry our tears, and to give us comfort and relief. Reader: “It was not you who chose Me, but I who chose you, and appointed you to go and bear fruit that will remain, so that whatever you ask the Father in My name, He may give you. This I command you: love one another.” (*John 15:16*)
