Classes are filled on a first come first serve basis. Register early to ensure a space in the class you want. If the class you want is full, add yourself to the **wait list** to ensure a space in the class if an opening becomes available. Wait lists are prioritized on a first come first serve basis. Registration for unfilled spaces may be available the first week of class, but you are strongly urged to register early.

MATERIAL FEES
