The American Chinese Crested Club will award at its National Specialty a three point major to Reserve Winners Dog if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

The American Chinese Crested Club will award at its National Specialty a three point major to Reserve Winners Bitch if the Regular Class Bitch entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

TRANSFER POLICY FOR THE SPECIALTIES AND TRIALS: The Clubs will permit a transfer to the next level class in accordance with AKC regulations. The request for a Transfer must be made in writing and presented to the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the specified event, show or trial. Transfer forms will be available at the Show Secretary's Table.

The following COVID-19 restriction is planned for the ACCC National week. If you plan to enter the show be advised we are governed by any protocols in effect at the time of the shows. If those protocols change after the shows close those changes will NOT constitute a reason to withdraw your entry. Please only enter if you are comfortable with the restriction below. CRUFTS QUALIFYING CERTIFICATES

The Kennel Club, England, has designated the AKC National Championship, sponsored by AKC and Royal Canin, as well as one designated AKC Parent Club National Specialty in each eligible breed, as the United States qualifying shows for Crufts. Recipients of Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Selects and Awards of Merit, and if offered at these events, Best Bred-by-Exhibitor, are eligible for entry in Crufts as a U.S. International qualifier.

The American Chinese Crested Club has chosen to designate the September 24, 2021 (2020) and the September 25/26, 2021 (2021) National Specialty as their Crufts qualifying show. Recipients of BOB, BOS, BBE, Awards of Merit, and Selects, will each be given an eligibility certificate to enter Crufts. Each certificate is good for Crufts entry in either 2022 or 2023, and must be submitted along with each entry for Crufts to verify qualification.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Classes for Dogs and Bitches (ACCC National Specialties Only)

Veteran (7-10 yrs): For dogs & bitches at least seven (7) years of age and under ten (10) years of age the day of the show

Veteran (10 yrs and older): For dogs & bitches at least ten (10) years of age and older the day of the show

Dogs/bitches entered in Veterans need not be intact. Winners of these classes, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible for Best of Breed competition

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

(ACCC National Specialties Only)

Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males may be entered as the Stud Dog & spayed females may be entered as the Brood Bitch.

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional entry fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the AKC Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard of the breed.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS - Two dogs with at least one or more common owner. The two dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. An entry form for a dog entered in another class & entered as a part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Class, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by one or more common owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be designated "Brace No 1, Brace No 2," etc. First Place only to be awarded. A Rosette will be awarded to First Place.

*****Please designate the other members of the Brace on the entry form for each dog*****

AWARDS OF MERIT - (where offered)

At the discretion of the judge up to five (5) Awards of Merit may be awarded in the Best of Breed judging. The winners of Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch are to be selected first and those winners are not eligible for Awards of Merit. A rosette will be given to each Award of Merit winner.

Best Puppy & Best Bred By Exhibitor judging will held following Best of Breed for those class winners who remain undefeated. No additional entry fee is required.

Master Class**

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - will be for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.

SWEEPSTAKES & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

(ACCC 2020 & 2021 Na. onal Specialties Only)

DIVISION OF PRIZE MONEY APPLIES TO SWEEPSTAKES & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

35% of total entry fees will be retained by the Club for expenses. The remaining 65% will be divided as follows:

First	30% of the total entry fees for each class
Second	20% of the total entry fees for each class
Third	10% of the total entry fees for each class
Fourth	5% of the total entry fees for each class

In cases where less than 4 specimens are shown, the payout will be determined as if the four were shown and the undistributed money shall accrue to the club.

Sweepstakes is open to all Chinese Cresteds that are 6 months & under 18 months of age on the day of the show. **For this year ONLY Champions of Record may be entered in Sweepstakes Classes.** Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class."

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches.

- Puppy, 6 Mos & Under 9 Mos • Puppy, 9 Mos & Under 12 Mos
- Junior, 12 Mos & Under 15 Mos • Junior, 15 Mos & Under 18 Mos
- Senior, 18 mos & Under 24 mos (Champions of record will be allowed to compete this year only)

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Chinese Cresteds, including Champions of Record that are at least 7 years of age on the day of the show. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular classes or at the regular entry fee. Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches may be shown in Veteran Sweepstakes. Indicate your Veteran Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided.

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches.

- Veteran, 7 Yrs & Under 10 Yrs • Veteran, 10 Yrs & Older

Refund for bitches who come into season after entries close will be given provided a written request for refund and veterinarian certificate is presented to the Show Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the beginning of trial.

The dog and its owner will continue to accrue points for any group placements or Bests in Show... The top-ranked dogs from the AKC National Owner-Handled Series are posted on the AKC National Owner-Handled Series Points Ranking page. Rankings of the dogs competing in the Series are compiled based on the Best of Breed, Group, and Best in Show placements in this specific Series competition (See Point Schedule). The end of year competition for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be held in conjunction with the AKC show in December. Dogs that finished ranked in the top ten (plus ties) for their breed during the qualifying period will be invited to compete in the competition. Dogs exhibited by professional handlers on the day of the event are not eligible for this competition. Dogs exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler on the day of the event are not eligible to enter this competition. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. 1. TELEPHONE RESERVATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

2. Motor home parking locations will be assigned by the RV Chair as you arrive at Holiday Inn. Groups wishing to park next to each other are encouraged to arrive at the same time. Every effort will be made to accommodate special requests. No areas will be saved. There will be NO UNRESERVED PARKING, and reservations can only be made through the RV Chair.
