




WHAT TO EXPECT

- 1- We suggest to have a confirmation and a shipping date before beginning any demolition or renovation work in your kitchen. At delivery, inspect your kitchen cabinets for missing or damaged parts as this may delay the installation. If you are hiring our Installation Service, our certified contractors can take you from "TO DO" to "DONE".
- 2- If you have selected the complete installation service, make sure you empty your old cupboards and drawers before the installers arrive. Remove anything that is attached to the walls and clear the counters. The installers will remove and replace your old cabinets and countertops, and then install the new appliances and flooring included in your project, if applicable.
- **3-** During installation, if your installers encounter a pre-existing or hidden problem that undermines the integrity of your project, they will inform you and the store of this and will decide if the situation must be resolved before proceeding with the project. We will provide you with solutions, depending on the problem. If additional charges apply, you can make an informed choice before the work resumes.
- **4-** According to the model of counter selected, expect to do without a sink for a few days. A delay may occur between installing your cabinets and preparing, delivering and installing your counter. You can ask the installer to put in a temporary countertop and sink for an additional cost.
- **5-** Although your installers make every effort to contain dust within the work area, it will no doubt spread to other parts of your home. We apologize for the inconvenience, while assuring you that your finished kitchen will make you forget these annoyances!
- **6-** While your kitchen is unusable, you will temporarily need a new way to prepare meals. Consider moving your microwave oven, refrigerator and small appliances to another room, or decide on another way to get your meals.
- **7-** For safety reasons, please keep children and pets away from the work area.
- **8-** Once installation is completed, the installers will do a final inspection with you to ensure that the results meet your expectations.





SAMPLE KITCHEN SKETCH FOR CABINETS & COUNTERTOPS

Please provide the dimensions of your space, including all wall dimensions showing window & door sizes with their locations. If you choose to have RONA do the install for this project we will send one of our installers to verify everything before the cabinets are ordered. If you are doing your own install, please be sure to take accurate measurements to ensure everything fits.

- Draw the layout of your entire kitchen including cabinets, countertops, doors, windows, heat registers, etc.
- Measure the sink window wall first.
- Start in the corner and measure (in inches) to the edge of the window trim.
- Record locations of existing sink, open cabinet space beneath the sink, stove/slide-in range, cooktop, refrigerator, dishwasher, range hoods.
- Record locations of electrical outlets and switches.
- Record the measurement from the wall to the sink centre.
- Measure windows & doors from outside trim to outside trim. Record measurements in the boxes above, as instructed.
- Show floor vents on floor plan. Measure distance of each vent from the wall.
- Measure from the wall in the corner to the end of the countertop in both directions.
- Measure all other countertops.
- Record any wall areas that you think may interfere with the countertop (ex. pipe chase, bowed walls, chimney, etc.)
