



The son of a Bedouin Sheikh developed this home to survive what has become of the world.


































Commercial work Building plots 8,9,10,11 Visualization

Al- Max fishing village restoration.


A fishing village developed by a multi-layered network between local's lifestyle and outsiders through the abstraction of series of guidelines of their urban life.




