A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required.

The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Lagotti Romagnoli, Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Keeshonden, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs and Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Boykin Spaniels and Whippets.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei and Chow Chows. This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions.

Ramps can be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds.

NOTICE

Juniors who win a third Novice Class with competition present, after the closing of entries for a show, **ARE REQUIRED TO TRANSFER** their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class **BY NOTIFYING** the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the event's Show Committee. Fastest Recall Competition

A Fastest Dog Recall Competition will be held Saturday, July 23rd, during the noon lunch break in the Obedience Warm up ring area. The event is sponsored by the Portland Dog Obedience Club, Inc.

The competition will consist of a single recall by each contestant. The contestant's dog will be left on a stay in any position at a pylon at one end of the ring. The contestant will leave their dog and stand behind another pylon located at the opposite end of the ring. Upon order to call from the in ring official the contestant will call their dog. The timing on the exercise will start when the command to call is given by the in ring official and will end when the competing dog has crossed the line of the pylon located in front of the handler. The recall does not have to be a formal obedience recall, and handlers may use any number of commands and verbal encouragement to get their dog to come to them.

Of course this would be too easy if the ring were without any distractions. The ring will have a number of stuffed and other dog toys scattered about the floor inside of the ring.

Entries will be taken at the time of the competition at ring side.

The entry fee will be \$1.00 per run collected at ring side, and contestants may run more than once as time permits. (For additional runs, contestants will have to get back into the line of waiting competitors after each run.) The competition will run for 45 minutes or less if all contestants have finished competing.

After 10% is deducted by the club, the first three fastest contestant times will split a share of the total Fastest Dog Recall Competition entry fees from this event only. The split will be:

First place = 50% Second Place = 25% Third Place = 15%

(Prize payments will be rounded up to the next full dollar amount.)


Ties in time for placement will be settled by a run off recall between the dogs tied by time.



Persons who are not reserving for the entire cluster may be assigned to designated areas according to day of departure. Specialty clubs requesting group parking must all reserve for the entire cluster.

These reservations must be post marked on or before July 6, 2016.

PARKING FEES --- Vendors will not be provided with free parking.

PRE-RESERVED OVERNIGHT \$50.00 per vehicle per night. (Extra vehicle \$30.00 for weekend.) OVERNIGHT AT GATE \$60.00 per vehicle per night.

- Overnight parking is 4:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M. the next day.

- Electric is \$70.00 flat fee.

Persons or groups parking together must be all electric

Box vans must use overnight-reserved facility (\$50.00 per day).

DAY PARKING - \$8.00 cash per vehicle per day (Oversized vehicles pay double).

Refund request must be in writing & postmarked on or before July 6, 2016 & will not be dispersed until after the show.

PERSONS RESERVING FOR ENTIRE PERIOD WILL HAVE CLOSER-IN PARKING

GENERAL PARKING

- 1. <u>All parking is at your own risk</u>. Neither the parking company nor the show giving clubs or show superintendent assumes any responsibility or liability for damage or loss to any vehicle, its contents, or dogs.
- 2. All RVs must be self-contained; those not following the parking rules are subject to a fine & bench committee hearing.
- 3. GATES: Will open at 6:00 A.M. Friday through Sunday, noon on Thursday.
- 4. Closing at 11:00 P.M. Thursday & Friday, 10:00 P.M. on Saturday.
- 5. UNLOADING: Unloading in designated areas only. A time limit per vehicle will be observed.
- 6. HANDICAP PARKING: Both days & overnight spaces will be available on a limited basis in accordance with the ADA. This does not guarantee close! Proof of eligibility will be required. OVERNIGHT-RESERVED PARKING INFORMATION
- 1. Reservations must be postmarked on or before July 6, 2016. All others will pay \$60.00 per day fee, cash, at the gate, for overnight.
- 2. All RVs must be self-contained. Anyone dumping gray water or sewage on the grounds will be subject to a \$500.00 fine.
- 3. For safety, all RVs must park in the same direction. All RVs must have working fire extinguishers of the required type.
- 4. Fire lanes must be kept open at all times. Unauthorized or illegally parked vehicles will be towed without prior warning & at the owner's expense. One extra car may be parked in a RV space by prior arrangement & purchase of weekend parking pass.
- 5. Generator times: 7:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M. Generators must be on the road end.
- 6. Confirmation of reservations will be sent only on a SELF-ADDRESSED, STAMPED POST CARD.
- 7. Requests to park together must arrive together in the same envelope.
- 8. Only reservations accompanied by fees will be accepted.



AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
