DAY 2: HALIFAX

Rafting tour and Mud Sliding (4 hrs)

Here the group will depart on a **Tidal Bore Rafting Excursion.** A unique, wet and wild two and four hour rafting adventure

We will start at our departure site and travel downstream with the outgoing tide to the mouth of the river. We will get to stretch our legs on a 200 acre sand bar until the Tidal bore arrives. Then we will hop in the boat and ride the rapids all the way back and past the departure site. Then we will travel back to the departure site. During the trip, the group will get the chance to Mud Slide. Mud-sliding is exactly what it sounds like. We'll find a big, steep hill of pure clay, climb to the top, and slid down it into the water!

After the Rafting & mud slide, guests will enjoy a hearty BBQ Lunch or a casual picnic lunch on the deck.



PROGRAM

Charlottetown is both the largest city on and the provincial capital of Prince Edward Island, and the county seat of Queens County. Named after Charlotte of Mecklenburg-Strelitz, queen consort of the United Kingdom, Charlottetown was first incorporated as a town in 1855 and designated as a city in 1885. It was most famously the site of the Charlottetown Conference in 1864, the first gathering of Canadian and Maritime statesmen to debate the proposed Maritime Union and the more persuasive British North American Union, now known as Canadian Confederation. From this, the city adopted as its motto "Cunabula Foederis" -- "Birthplace of Confederation".
