



CEGEP OPTIONS:

Two Categories of Programs

3 Year Career Programs

2 Year Pre-University Programs

Prepare students for the world of work.

- Develop marketable knowledge and skills
- Often include stage/internship
- Lead to real jobs/certification
- Student can still go on to university (may need to take additional pre-requisites for c hosen university program.
- Some university programs offer advanced standing to graduates of 3-year CEGEP programs.

e.g. Police Technology, Respiratory and Anesthesia Technology, Special Care Counselling, Business Administration, Computer Science, Dental Hygiene etc. Prepares students for university studies.

- Theoretical rather than "hands-on"
- Include university pre-requisites in the program.
- Limited practical value IF the student does not attend university -
- Does not develop the skills or competencies to obtain a career in that field without further study.

e.g. Social Sciences, Liberal Arts, Commerce, Pure and Applied Sciences, Health Sciences, Music, Creative Arts, Languages, and Literature etc.

- 3. Make sure you complete **SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS**


Examples:

- 8. Don't be afraid to call Admissions with your child


