Greeting Sisters and Brothers:

I greet you in the strong and powerful Name of Jesus Christ our Savior!

I pray that all is well with you and your families, especially as we go through these unprecedented times. I am pleased and very grateful that you decided to honor the Father through prayer by participating in *Praying With Purpose Ministries' Virtual Prayer Vigil 2020* which the Lord placed on my heart.

In September 2008, while studying the book of Isaiah, in preparation to teach a Bible class, the Spirit of the living God spoke to my heart through Isaiah 22:20–24. He instructed me to look up the name *Eliakim*, which means "God raises up" or "God sets up." What God said next both astonished and amazed me. He said. "*That is what I have done for Barack Obama*."* Motivated by the words God spoke to me, I began to study this passage for more insight. The Holy Spirit revealed to me that God was going to raise then-Senator Barack Obama to the office of President of the United States of America and give him "the key of the house of David," which reminded me of a passage in the book of Revelation. I pray you will continue to grow in the knowledge of God our heavenly Father and in Jesus; so that grace and peace may be multiplied to each one of you abundantly. I look forward to our virtual gathering with great expectations.

A SEASON OF PRAYER

- PRAYER POINTS -

FIRST SEASON: Focusing on God, Savior Jesus Christ and the Unsaved

- We want to experience the Manifest Presence of God by praising, giving thanks and exalting His Holy Name like the 24 elders in Revelation 4:9–5, using the Psalms to guide us (Psalms 145–150). See handout with the Names of God.
- Pray for the Unsaved to honor God by: Accepting provision for their salvation (John 3:16)

Receiving His Grace (Ephesians 2:8)

Confessing (Romans 10:9–10)

SECOND SEASON: Government Leaders and Presidential Election

- Pray for the healing, health and well-being of our President and other government officials/leaders (Jeremiah 30:17; 33:6; Psalm 30:2–3)
- Pray for godly wisdom and counsel for government officials/leaders: (James 3:17–18; Proverbs 11:14; 3:5–6)

President and Administration (Proverbs 21:1; 29:4, 7; Zechariah 7:9–10)

Senators and House Representatives (Proverbs 22:17–25)

Supreme Court Justices and Judges (Amos 5:24)

Governors, Mayors, Police Officers, etc. (Micah 6:8)

• Pray Congress will pass a stimulus bill to help the people in need. (Proverbs 19:17)





 Pray for Presidential Election — that it will be fair and just, no voter suppression, fraud and/or domestic/international interference (Isaiah 54:14–15; 8:10; Psalm 33:10; Matthew 10:26) Bind satanic harassment:

> Ridicule (Nehemiah 4:1–6) Intimidation (Nehemiah 4:7–9) Discouragement (Nehemiah 4:10) Fear (Nehemiah 4:11–23)

• Pray that the people's eyes are opened and no longer deceived (John 12:40)

THIRD SEASON: Repentance, Revival & Restoration (2 Chronicles 7:13–15 and Isaiah 58:6–12)

- The Church bind the religious spirit of hypocrisy, "Pharisaic" (Mark 7:6–13; Psalm 85)
- The Country bind the spirit of greed (god of wealth, Mammon); idolatry which expresses itself in the form of "social injustice"; oppressing the poor and needy (1 Timothy 6:10; Amos 5:6–7, 10–15, 24)
- The Community, especially for restoration of homes/properties, etc. (Nehemiah 5:3–12)

Corporate Prayers:

 School System: Quality education for all students (Proverbs 4:25-27; 29:15b)

Safe and conducive environment (Psalm 91:9–11); divine protection; Psalm 121)

Administrators and teachers (Psalms 32:8; 138:8; James 3:17–18; Philippians 4:13, 19)

• Military — protection, strength and morale (Isaiah 41:10–13; Psalm 91:9–11)
