



Pre-Approved Paint & Stain Colors

The colors on the following pages are digital representations of the actual paint sample chips that are pasted on paper and presented in a binder notebook that is available for homeowners to borrow from the Architecture Committee. At the time of this writing, all of these samples are still available at the various paint stores mentioned.

In 2003, Drumaldry's Architecture Committee updated and reintroduced a listing of pre-approved color choices. Now, ten years later, Duron has been purchased by Sherwin-Williams; and the Duron colors no longer exist. Sherwin-Williams can still mix paint from the old Duron books and lists but samples and charts are no longer available. During this review we noted that some popular colors from the original builder's list and some from earlier pre-approved color lists dating from 1993 and 1997 had been removed. We have reinstated those colors and have added a couple of new colors, too.

Door and Panel Colors

Original color combinations for a home included one color for the siding, the dark brown color for the trim, a third color for doors and window panels that were either painted to match doors or were a fourth color. Over the years some homeowners did not realize that window panels were to be an accent color and they have been painted the same color as the siding. This practice has now been pre-approved. (See pages 1 & 2 for Door and Panel Colors.)

- ◆ The door and panel colors that were close to or matched the siding colors have been moved – they are now included on the siding list. **ALL COLORS ON THE SIDING LIST CAN NOW BE USED ON DOORS AND PANELS.** This makes matching your siding and doors easier if you like that look.
- ◆ The top two beige colors are close matches to the almond or beige pre-painted garage doors.
- ◆ Whether you match your doors to your siding or not, be sure to use a semi-gloss paint on your doors.

Siding Colors

Wood Siding

Since the beginning, homeowners have been required to use stain on the cedar siding and trim of their homes. This was no accident or design folly. Wood stain is a superior product and remains the best coating for natural wood. It does not peel, it gets absorbed and protects the wood. And, it can be used over bare wood without primer. In fact, primer would negate the properties just described.

Many owners in the past, not knowing of these qualities, have painted their homes with exterior paint. The telltale sign that your house has been painted rather than stained is peeling and cracking paint. If your house has been painted, stain will no longer be a suitable alternative; stain does not adhere properly to painted surfaces.

HardiePanel

HardiePanel has been approved for use in replacing the cedar board & batten siding that is increasingly in need of repair or replacement. Wood stain should not be used on concrete board. The siding sheets come primed and are painted after installation if you don't choose one of the approved pre-painted color choices. (See page 6 for Pre-finished HardiePanel.)

Siding Color Charts

The color samples on the enclosed charts are based on the Cabot Stains that have been our approved colors since the homes were built. Over the years, many colors from several companies have been approved for use. Many of these colors are identical to the Cabot colors, some are slightly different. Some names such as "Cape Cod Gray" could actually be 3 or 4 different colors. In order to make sense of this, the colors have been condensed and are arranged on the charts in related groups: lighter colors, warm grays, cool grays, tan & cedar colors, browns and sage greens. Each grouping usually has a lighter, medium and darker version. (See pages 3 & 4 for Siding Colors.)

- ◆ Cabot stains are available at: Strosniders, Glen Echo Hardware, Lowe's, and Lu Paint in Rockville.
- ◆ The Duron Maxwood product that many of us have used for the past 10 years has been phased out. The Sherwin-Williams replacement is called Woodscapes. S-W will mix the stain to match any of the Sherwin-Williams samples on our chart. There is a sample Woodscapes brochure in the pocket of the paint binder notebook if you are interested.
- ◆ Benjamin Moore makes a wood stain, Arborcoat, that is a high end product and comes with a separate finishing coat. Arborcoat and their more standard stain are available at Monarch Paint at Chevy Chase Circle and at Glen Echo. They will also mix the stain to match any Benjamin Moore paint sample. Although Strosnider does carry Benjamin Moore Paints, they no longer carry the stain. There is a sample stain brochure in the binder pocket.
- ◆ Behr, available at Home Depot, has a separate color chart for their stains. Unfortunately, the chart is printed rather than having paint chips. It is impossible to select a house color from it.
- ◆ Home Depot will mix stains to match any color from the Behr paint list on our list.
- ◆ The Valspar listing is for paint only. Lowe's carries Cabot and Olympic Stains. There is a sample Olympic brochure in the binder pocket.

Brochures for the following products are in the binder pocket of the Paint Notebook: Sikkens Rubbol is a new product from Europe that is a hybrid alkyd/acrylic coating that can be used on wood as well as HardiePanel. It is available at Strosnider and Glen Echo. Sherwin-Williams Loxon is a product recommended for concrete board – There is an information sheet for this in the back of the binder.

Benjamin Moore has a couple products of interest:

- ◆ Aura is an exterior latex paint that is low VOC and has a lifetime warranty for peeling and flaking. Benjamin Moore considers this their top of the line product.
- ◆ Affinity Exterior Paint is another of Moore's higher-end latex products.

Trim Color Chart

Across the top are the Cabot colors that are approved for use on trim. The corresponding paint matches are below them. (Please see page 5 for Trim Colors.)

Please use only flat finish coatings on siding and trim.
