TestDaF – Aim and concept

The TestDaF (Test of German as a foreign language)

- is a standardised proficiency test
- measures language skills on an advanced level (B2/C1 of CEFR)
- contains topics and contents related to studies
- tests abilities that are highly relevant for studying
- → Certificate of sufficient language skills for studying at a German university





TestDaF – Aim and concept

The TestDaF

- measures four abilities separately:
 - Reading comprehension
 - Listening comprehension
 - Writing
 - Speaking
- Divides between three different proficiency levels:

"TestDaF-Niveaustufen": TDN3, TDN 4, TDN 5






Development of TestDaF attendance








Country of origin of TestDaF candidates

High: result in all subtests at least TDN4 Medium: result in all subtests at least TDN3






