

Admission Requirements

First-Time Freshman

- 15 unit college preparatory subject requirement (a-g)
- GPA and test scores
- Graduation from high school

Tip: Advise students to take as many college preparatory courses as possible and successfully complete them with a grade of "C" or better.

GPA (10th-12th) & Test Scores

SAT

(GPA___ x 800) + SAT (scores in Math & Critical Reading)=

Minimum 2900 for CA resident, 3502 for non- CA resident

ACT

(GPA___ x 200) + (ACT composite score x 10)=

Minimum 694 for CA resident, 842 for non- CA resident

Tip: Advise students to take SAT or ACT no later than Dec. of senior year

Transfer Requirements

- 60 or more transferable college units (90 quarter units)
- 2.0 GPA on all college or university units attempted & be in good standing at last college/university attended

Application Tips

- Admitting on self-report information accuracy is very important!
- Student name given in the application for admission must match the name used to register for the SAT/ACT
- Create "My CSU" account (to check application Status)
- Pay attention to deadlines
- □ Take tests early (SAT, ACT, EPT & ELM)
- Complete ALL admission requirements (admissions is provisional)
- □ Have a back up plan and follow through with all deadlines!!
