This grand character is reflected in Dinesen Douglas, each plank showing the distinctive grain and slightly reddish tone. Nature's power and beauty are preserved in the planks, awaken our senses and last for generations.

Our Douglas planks create an elegant and harmonious expression with any choice of dimensions and composition. Choose between different variants, patterns, lengths and widths to achieve your desired impression – grand and extravagant, calm and exclusive or vibrant and dynamic. Every Dinesen Douglas solution reflects the high quality of the wood and captures the majesty of the douglas tree.

Dinesen Douglas is divided into two variants, each with its own expression that gives the planks their distinct character.

#### Dinesen Douglas

Dinesen Douglas is made of raw wood sourced from the Black Forest and other European forests that have been family-owned for generations and sustainably managed for centuries. Douglas firs are felled when they are 80 to 120 years old. Since only the best make it through the eye of the needle, we strive to maximize the lifespan of the selected trees. The tree's posture, height and age are crucial for the quality and durability of the raw wood that turns into our Douglas planks. The planks are made from carefully selected wood from the lower 15 metres of the Douglas tree, while the rest of the wood is used elsewhere.

Throughout a long lifetime, the trees have demonstrated their resilience and ability to withstand the ravages of time. The result is mature trees characterized by excellent stability and durability. Thanks to the thorough selection process and extraordinary craftsmanship, the finished floor will last have at least as long a lifetime as the tree in the forest.

#### The 'eye of the needle'

To ensure top-quality planks, each tree is subjected to strict quality criteria for straightness, growth rings and knots. Only a select few meet the standards for a harmonious and enduring Dinesen product. In order to maximise the lifespan of the selected trees, we strive to utilise all of the raw wood.



#### **Knots**


A Dinesen floor is a piece of nature - a living material with its own story. Our goal is to deliver harmonious floors that bring you closer to nature. A knot is the part of a branch that is embedded in the trunk, and it tells the story of the tree's life and vitality. We wish to preserve the natural expression and bring out the beauty of the raw wood. As the knots are an important part of this story, we carefully repair or replace knots as part of our quality control. This improves the quality of the plank and ensures a respectful use of the tree. New knots are carefully attached with knot glue, and a hot-melt adhesive is used as a filler for any tiny gaps in the wood or knots that do not need to be replaced. Based on the length, width and visual appearance of the plank, we assess the number and sizes of knots, medullar rays, pith repairs and so forth as the individual planks pass through our hands.

We cannot provide a precise specification but refer you to the images on the following pages. The photos show examples of planks in Classic and Natural variants and offer a representative, but not exhaustive, impression of their visual appearance, including grain and knots.

### Random lengths

Price list 01/05

Planks are delivered in random lengths, always as long as possible. Varying lengths produce a dynamic effect with fluid transitions between rooms that create a coherent expression. A floor in random lengths is a sustainable choice that maximises the utilisation of the raw wood. All the listed prices are stated per m2.

<sup>\*</sup>Our planks are produced in random lengths within a defined interval, for example 1–3 metres or 2–5 metres. We produce the planks continuously, based on the availability of raw wood, and aim for an average length in the middle of the interval with a small share of shorter and longer planks. The planks are profiled on all four sides.

Full length planks are an elegant and exclusive solution where the planks extend in their full length from wall to wall and fill out the space. The clean lines create a harmonious look and underscore the architectural expression. A floor in full length planks appears simultaneously simple and grand. As the production of full length planks requires large amounts of raw wood, the delivery time may be longer. All the listed prices are stated per m2.


#### Pattern


#### Herringbone


#### Mosaic

#### About the planks

This price list and photo series offers a representative but not exhaustive impression of the number of knots, grain structure and visual appearance overall. The price list does not cover all variants and natural occurrences. Thus, 2–3% of the planks must be expected to display minor deviations.

A Dinesen floor is a natural product in the best sense of the word and the sorting will thus always reflect the natural character of the wood.

The planks are CE-labelled and produced in accordance with Dinesen's factory standards with reference to EN 14342;2013. Declaration of Performance (DOP) is available at dinesen.com.

Drying, sorting and production take place at our factory in the town of Jels, Denmark. The planks are delivered with a moisture content of 8% +/- 1% and are suited for underfloor heating.

The planks are delivered unfinished and need to be sanded and finished as part of the installation. Dimensions and thicknesses are defined in the current price list, which is available at dinesen.com.
