





- Be engaged in oral presentation in front of audience
- Participate in discussions between and among peers and use literary devises to present their points of view.

Tips for Parents

- ENJOY learning with your child and make his/her learning fun
- READ Encourage your child to read storybooks, newspapers and educational magazines, etc...
- TALK Spend time to talk to him/her and get him/her to talk about:
 - what he/she has read, watched, experienced, etc...
 - the gist of the story
- ASK using 'What?', 'Why?' & 'How?'
- SUPPORT Get him/her to support/justify what he/she says with details and evidence
- REFERENCE Encourage him/her to refer to authentic sources for reference e.g. dictionary
- MONITOR your child's learning and progress and reinforce the positive learning habits
