



<u>Audit</u> Yesterday the school was part of the DEC's cyclical audit process. I am pleased to say the our method of operation in finance and Work Health and Safety was deemed successful by the auditor. We await further training and information regarding our impending involvement in LMBR (Learning Management and Business Reform) program which will drastically streamline our methods of money handling, record keeping and school management.

<u>Garden competition</u> Last Monday our school was judged in the Hawkesbury Garden Competition. I was able to escort our judges Charlie and Murray through the school, pointing out the improvements to our students' playground environment, entrance to the school and the vegetable garden. We eagerly await the results.

<u>Vegelantes</u> Our 'Vegelantes' spent this afternoon preparing and planting the vegetable garden with a range of vegetables for the coming season. Thanks to the Stanton family for donating the many seedlings which will now hopefully take off in the warmer weather. The students planted beans, squash, pumpkin, capsicum, zucchini and rock melon. Shed We are in need of vounteers to put together our garden shed once the concrete slab has been formed and poured. The shed is in kit form and would need to be assembled by Week 3 next term. 
These drafts will be further published and, you never know, we might see them entering the senate in a few years' time.
