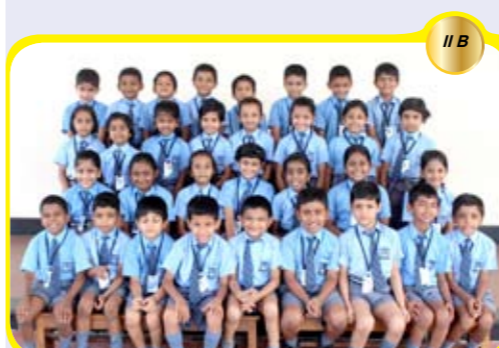
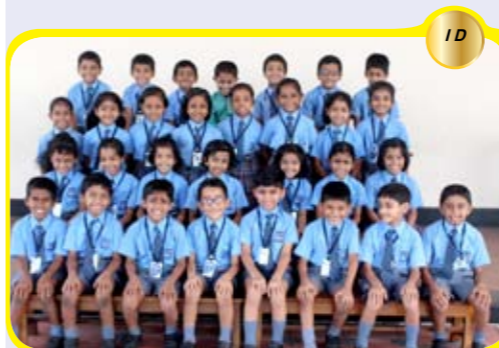
CHENNAI RELIEF FUND
