

PROCLAIMING THE GOSPEL --

THE GOOD NEWS OF JESUS CHRIST

Having grown up in an apostate Protestant church, I did not hear the gospel – the Good News of Jesus Christ. Even as an adult in my third decade, after I made that one time decision to trust in Jesus as my savior, I was amazed that the so-called gospel presentations were weak and diluted by words and phrases that do not even appear in the Bible. (A list of those phrases appears at the end of this document.) These phrases were stumbling blocks to my understanding of the way, the truth, and the life.

Since Johnny clearly teaches that the power of the church (that is, the collective body of those who have placed their trust in Jesus for the erasing of their sins and receiving the gift of eternal life) determines whether our culture is dark or light (and the brightness thereof), clarification of what comprises the Good News of Jesus Christ seems paramount. May this collection of verses reveal and/or enhance your understanding of:

The Gospel -- The Good News of Jesus Christ!

Important points to know when presenting the good news of Jesus Christ:

All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

The wages of sin is death – that is,
a person is separated from God for all eternity.

Jesus is God.

Jesus is our sin substitute. He took our sins upon Himself.

Jesus went to the cross and died in our place.

Jesus took our penalty of separation for all eternity on our behalf.

Every person who makes a one-time decision to trust in Jesus as his savior
has all his sins erased and receives the gift of eternal life.

*Note: (JM Tatum) refers to Johnny M. Tatum's translations from either:
the Septuagint {the Greek translation of the Old Testament} or
the United Bible Society's Greek Critical Text {New Testament}*

The following verses emphasize the importance of using Scripture
when presenting the good news of Jesus Christ

The word of the LORD is pure,
bringing faith into the soul. Psalm 19:8 (JM Tatum)

The unfolding of Your words gives light;
it gives understanding to the simple. Psalm 119: 130

I have more insight than all my teachers,
for Your testimonies are what I hum. Psalm 119: 99 (JM Tatum)

Forever, O LORD, Your word is settled in heaven. Psalm 119: 89

You light my lamp;
the LORD my God illumines my darkness. Psalm 18: 28

I do not underestimate the gospel {that is, the Good News},
for it is the power of God which produces salvation
to everyone who trusts {in Jesus}. Romans 1:16 (JM Tatum)

As for God, His way is blameless;
the word of the LORD is proven; Psalm 18:30 (JM Tatum)

Every word of God is tested and proven;
He is a shield to those who take refuge in Him.
Do not add to His words
or He will reprove you, and you will be proved a liar.
Proverbs 30: 5-6 (JM Tatum)

He sent His word and healed them,
and delivered them from their destructions. Psalm 107: 20

Sanctify them {set them apart} in the truth;
Your word is truth. John 17: 17

So will My word be which goes forth from My mouth;
It will not return to Me empty,
Without accomplishing what I desire,
And without succeeding *in the matter* for which I sent it. Isaiah 55: 11

The sword of the Spirit is the word of God. Ephesians 6:17

THE BAD NEWS:

(Understanding the bad news is necessary in order to understand the good news)

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, Romans 3:23

For the wages of sin is death Romans 6:23

“death” in the Bible never refers to extinction; the word means “separation”
from God – true for all who do not trust Jesus as their savior.

“the second death”: those who appear before the Great White Throne
judgment seat will be separated from God for all eternity

For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles in one *point*,
he has become guilty of all. James 2:10

If we say that we have no sin, we are deceiving ourselves and
the truth is not in us. 1 John 1:8

Therefore, just as through one man {that is, Adam} sin entered into the world, and
death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned. Romans 5:12

The fool has said in his heart, “There is no God,”
They are corrupt, they have committed abominable deeds;
There is no one who does good. Psalm 14: 1

For we also once were foolish ourselves, disobedient, deceived,
enslaved to various lusts and pleasures, spending our life
in malice and envy, hateful, hating one another. Titus 3: 3

And He {Jesus} was saying, “That which proceeds out of the man, that is what defiles
the man. For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed the evil thoughts,
fornications, thefts, murders, adulteries, deeds of coveting and wickedness,
as well as deceit, sensuality, envy, slander, pride and foolishness.
All these evil things proceed from within and defile the man.” Mark 7: 20-23

Now the deeds of the flesh are manifested in these ways: immorality, impurity,
sensuality, idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, disputes,
dissensions, factions, envying, thinking stupidly, acting stupidly, drunkenness, carousing,
and things like these, of which I forewarn you, just as I have forewarned you, that those
who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. Galatians 5: 19-21 (JM Tatum)

THE GOOD NEWS:

*Jesus is God (He is holy and righteous),
the one and only person who can deliver a human being
from the ultimate consequences of his sin →*

SEPARATION FROM GOD FOR ALL ETERNITY IN HELL

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God,
and the Word was God.

He was in the beginning with God.

All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him
nothing came into being that has come into being.

In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men.

The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it. ...

And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us,
and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father,
full of grace and truth. John 1: 1-4, 14

{Jesus} “You will know the truth, and the truth will make you free.” John 8: 32

Jesus said to him {Thomas}, “I am the way, the truth, the life;
no one comes to the Father but through Me.” John 14:6

If you say Jesus is God, and trust with your will that God raised Him from the dead,
you will be saved; for one trusts with the will, producing righteousness, and
one agrees {that is, he is a sinner} producing salvation. Romans 10: 9-10 (JM Tatum)

Heal me, O Lord, and I will be healed;
save me and I will be saved. Jeremiah 17: 14

They {Paul & Silas} said, “Trust in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved.” Acts 16: 31

And to him who responds to what he knows *{i.e., “what he knows is true”}*
I shall show the salvation of God.” Psalm 50:23 (JM Tatum)

He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross,
so that we would die to sin and live to righteousness;
for by His wounds you were healed. 1 Peter 2: 24

I have been crucified with Christ;
and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me;
and the life which I now live in the flesh I live
by faith in the Son of God,
who loved me and gave Himself up for me. Galatians 2: 20

For the wages of sin is death,
but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 6:23

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever
trusts in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life. John 3: 16

If we confess our sins *{i.e., a one-time act}*, He is faithful and righteous
to erase our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
1 John 1: 8-9 (JM Tatum)

For by grace you have been saved through faith;
and that *{faith is}* not of yourselves,
it *{that is, faith}* is a gift of God;
not as a result of works,
so that no one may boast. Ephesians 2: 8-9 (JM Tatum)

In all things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us.
For I am convinced that neither death, nor life,
nor angels, nor principalities,
nor things present, nor things to come,
nor powers, nor height, nor depth,
nor any other created thing,
will be able to separate us from the love of God,
which is in Christ Jesus our Lord .
Romans 8: 37-39

A SAMPLE PRAYER TRUSTING JESUS AS YOUR SAVIOR:

Dear Heavenly Father,

According to Your word (the Bible),

I am a sinner.

I cannot save myself from the consequences of my sin.

But I choose to trust Your Word that says, because Jesus loved me,

He took my sins in His body (in the Garden of Gethsemane),

He went to the cross and died in my place - as my substitute –

paying the penalty for my sins in His body,

of being separated (in outer darkness) from God for all eternity.

I am putting my trust in You, Jesus, as my savior.

Thank you, Jesus, for dying for me, erasing my sins, and giving me eternal life.

Romans 6:23

Ephesians 2: 8-9

Galatians 2: 20

1 Peter 2: 24

Isaiah 53: 4-6, 10-12

Acts 16: 31

John 14: 6

1 John 5: 13

WHY WE WANT TO BE ABLE TO CLEARLY ARTICULATE THE GOSPEL

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might.

Put on the full armor of God,
so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil.
For our struggle is not against flesh and blood,
but against the rulers, against the powers,
against the world forces of this darkness,
against the spiritual *forces* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*.

Therefore, take up the full armor of God, so that you will be able to resist
in the evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm.

Stand firm therefore, HAVING GIRDED YOUR LOINS WITH TRUTH,
and HAVING PUT ON THE BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS,
and having shod YOUR FEET WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE;

in addition to all, taking up the shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish
all the flaming arrows of the evil *one*.

And take THE HELMET OF SALVATION,
and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. Ephesians 6: 10-17

Brothers and sisters, sharpen your swords – Jesus is coming!

WHAT the Gospel IS NOT

(Note: **None** of these **appear** in the Bible!
All are **additions** to the Gospel)

“ASK JESUS IN YOUR HEART”

“COMMIT / GIVE / YIELD / SURRENDER YOUR LIFE TO CHRIST”

“TURN FROM YOUR SINS”

“MAKE JESUS LORD OF YOUR LIFE”

“ACCEPT JESUS AS LORD & SAVIOR”

“BE WILLING TO FOLLOW JESUS IN OBEDIENCE”

“ASK JESUS IN YOUR HEART”

This is the first example of a popular saying that is not found in the Bible. It can even be scary for young children who think in concrete terms and images. Some are actually afraid that a person would be crawling around inside their body.

Rather: *Ask Jesus to be YOUR savior.*

“Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures” 1 Corinthians 15:3

Thank you Jesus, that You loved me and gave Yourself up for me.” Galatians 2:20

“COMMIT / GIVE / YIELD / SURRENDER YOUR LIFE TO CHRIST”

Examples of meaningless phrases, each of which would be nothing more than works of the flesh.

Rather: *Jesus, I choose to place my trust in You as my savior.
I know that You died on the cross in my place,
taking the punishment for my sins.*

“Trust in the Lord Jesus Christ and you will be saved.” Acts 16: 31

"TURN FROM YOUR SINS"

Yet another example of a work of the flesh – an impossible task for a human being.
If you had the power to turn from your sins, you would not need a savior.

Rather: Turn to Jesus – THE way, THE truth, THE life –

no one comes to the Father except through Jesus. John 14: 6

"MAKE JESUS LORD OF YOUR LIFE"

This is -- an empty phrase devoid of meaning as is proven by the fact
that no one explains what that means.

What is important is that Jesus is **God**. No mentally stable human being can claim he is God. It took the holy **God**-man Jesus Christ dying a bloody death to pay for your sins.

Romans 10:9-10 has been horribly mistranslated in every translation saying, "If you confess with your mouth Jesus is Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation."

Instead the correct translation is:

If you say "Jesus is God",
and trust with your will that God
raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

For one trusts with the will, producing righteousness,
and one agrees {he is a sinner},
producing salvation.

Romans 10: 9-10 (JM Tatum)

What a difference to realize that **God** died for you, paying for your sins. And that trusting in Jesus as your sin substitute is a decision of your mind / will, NOT an emotion.

"ACCEPT JESUS AS LORD AND SAVIOR"

This is merely a modified version of **"MAKE JESUS LORD OF YOUR LIFE"**.

"BE WILLING TO FOLLOW JESUS IN OBEDIENCE"

Another extra-biblical man-made command demanding continuous focus on the performance of your flesh.

Are you so foolish? Having begun by the Spirit,
are you now being perfected by the flesh? Galatians 3: 3

Rather: for God is the one bringing it about in you,
both the desire and the doing of what pleases Him.
Philippians 2: 13 (JM Tatum)

Explanation of the verse: *Now this verse states clearly that, since we do not have the ability to please Him or the desire to please Him, God takes it upon Himself to produce our desire. He also takes upon Himself the responsibility to produce the desired results in our lives.* (JM Tatum)

Final exhortation: focus on studying God's word so you can learn how to listen to His voice {which never contradicts His written word - properly translated}, and share the Good News with others.

The word of the LORD is pure, bringing faith into the soul. Psalm 19: 8 (JM Tatum)

Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path. Psalm 119: 105

O send out Your light and Your truth, let them lead me. Psalm 43: 3

But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; John 16: 13

Your ears will hear a word behind you, "This is the way, walk in it,"
whenever you turn to the right or to the left. Isaiah 30: 21

So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the spoken voice of Christ.
Romans 10: 17 (JM Tatum)

{“remah” – the spoken voice of Christ through Holy Spirit}

{God} who has saved us, and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was granted us in Christ Jesus from all eternity, but now has been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Christ Jesus, who abolished death, and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel (that is, the Good News of Jesus Christ).
