



ASSOCIATE OF ARTS IN ACCOUNTING

The Associate of Arts in Accounting can prepare you for a variety of accounting careers in business, government and not-for-profit organizations. Explore the theory and practice of financial accounting, managerial accounting, cost accounting, accounting information systems and tax, as well as a broad knowledge of a range of business disciplines.

ASSOCIATE OF ARTS IN APPLIED PSYCHOLOGY

Combining liberal arts education and a scientific approach to understanding human behavior, the Associate of Arts in Applied Psychology will give you the skills and knowledge that are in fields such as psychology, sociology, business, legal studies and counseling. You'll identify principles of effective research, critical thinking and personal development.

ASSOCIATE OF ARTS IN AVIATION MANAGEMENT

This accounting major can prepare you for careers in a variety of business, government and not-for-profit organizations.

BACHELOR OF ARTS IN APPLIED PSYCHOLOGY

In addition to expanding your knowledge of behavioral theories, the Bachelor of Arts in Applied Psychology curriculum introduces how to effectively identify, understand and develop practical solutions to problems facing today's organizations. This degree program allows you to choose electives from four popular concentrations, including Child Advocacy, Clinical Psychology, Forensic Psychology and Organizational Psychology.

BACHELOR OF ARTS IN APPLIED PSYCHOLOGY WITH A CONCENTRATION IN CHILD ADVOCACY

Develop a foundation of theory and practice for a career in child advocacy with the Bachelor of Arts in Applied Psychology with a Concentration in Child Advocacy. You will cultivate the skills required of child advocates, who serve in such roles as youth counselor, victim advocate, child development specialist and child welfare specialist.

TRANSFER CREDITS

We consider transfer credits from accredited secondary and post-secondary institutions. They are evaluated according to the transfer credit policy published in the <u>university catalog</u>.

WHAT TYPES OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE ARE AVAILABLE?

CORPORATE TUITION ASSISTANCE

Many companies recognize the need for their employees to enhance their skill base and advance their education. Corporate tuition assistance may cover per-credit-hour costs, in addition to books and materials. For more information, contact your Human Resources department.

FEDERAL STUDENT AID

Federal Student Aid programs are the largest source of student aid in America. Take advantage of this opportunity by determining your eligibility with the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

FEDERAL DIRECT LOANS

These student loans must be repaid and may be available to eligible undergraduate and graduate students. If you qualify for a subsidized Federal Direct loan, the government will pay the interest on your loan while you are in school.

ALTERNATIVE LOANS

Paying for higher education is a significant financial commitment. A variety of financial institutions offer private education loan products which can supplement other financial aid to help manage college costs.

PARENT PLUS LOANS

Dependent undergraduate students may be eligible for a Parent PLUS Loan. Parent PLUS Loans are additional unsubsidized loans made out to the parents of dependent students to help the student pay for education expenses. Maximum eligibility is the cost of attendance minus all other financial assistance. If a parent applies and does not qualify for a Parent PLUS Loan, the student may receive additional unsubsidized Federal Direct (Stafford) Loans.

FEDERAL PELL GRANTS

Federal Pell Grants are available to undergraduate students only. Grants do not have to be repaid. The maximum Pell Grant for the 2020-21 academic award year is \$6,345.

TUITION SUPPORT FOR OUR NATION'S MILITARY

Florida Tech welcomes servicemembers from all branches and their family members who have sacrificed for our country to attend our university for special military pricing, regardless of where they are stationed.

SPECIAL MILITARY PRICING

Undergraduate: We offer a special undergraduate tuition rate of \$250 per credit hour for active-duty servicemembers, selected Reservists and National Guard members and their spouses. We're also proud to offer a 10% tuition savings for honorably discharged veterans and their spouses.

Graduate: We offer a 10% graduate tuition savings for activeduty servicemembers, selected Reservists, National Guard members and honorably discharged veterans, and their spouses.

Reductions are valid off the standard tuition and program fee rate of any degree or certificate offered through Bisk Education. This reduction is not stackable with other reductions, and you may not use this reduction in conjunction with other reductions.



VETERANS

All Florida Tech college-credit degree programs are state approved for VA educational benefits.
