On the topic of partnerships – the Little Theatre will once again be partnering with Geva Theatre Center on a series of screenings this month in celebration of their performance of Guess Who's Coming to Dinner. The Little will present four Sidney Poitier films throughout November in conjunction with the play – Guess Who's Coming to Dinner, In the Heat of the Night, To Sir with Love and A Raisin in the Sun. 
