ORDERED,

THAT all Affidavits, as well for Prefenting as Accounting, be, fo far as they can be procured, printed.

THAT to each Prefenting Affidavit be annexed a certificate, figned by the Confervator or principal Overfeer, flating that the work is neceffary; and also a certificate, figned by the Acting Overfeer, flating the rates of wages at which he has made his effimate. That each Car fhall draw at least fix hundred weight of gravel, and also that he has effimated the damages likely to be occasioned by taking gravel, and the diffance at which it is fituated from the centre of the perches to be repaired.

THAT on all roads to be repaired, the ftones be broken fmall before the gravel is laid on; and that to each Accounting Affidavit be annexed a certificate, figned by the Confervator or principal Overfeer, ftating that the work is well executed.

THAT it is advifeable to poftpone, until the Map of the County now executing by Mr. WM. LARKIN, be completed, the opening of any new line of road in this County, except in continuation of any road already in part opened in this or any adjoining County, or where circumftances of the cleareft public utility thall appear to render a fpeedier formation of any fuch new road manifeftly defirable.
