

Provider Enrollment and Management System (PEMS)

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Benefits

New system will modernize, consolidate, and streamline provider enrollment into Texas Medicaid

- Online "smart" provider enrollment application and provider agreement
- Single system for managing information, paper apps will only accepted on exception basis – VDP, MCO LTSS, LTC
- NPI-based enrollment, revalidation, paper claims and prior authorization submissions
- Shortened timeline for enrollment and revalidation with real-time workflows, electronic application validation, and error checking
- User-centric design with enhanced communication capabilities such as status alerts and automatic reminders for upcoming due dates
- Online provider look-up including practice locations and 'tele' services

Current vs. Future State

Today

August 2021

Multiple systems (PEP,PIMS,PPM,PETS) > One system=PEMS

TPI-based enrollment > One NPI-based enrollment

Lengthy paper and online application > One dynamic smart application (no paper)

Multiple, varied provider agreements > One dynamic smart provider agreement

Varied required enrollment support > One standardized set of enrollment forms documents

Multiple provider communications > One provider message board

PEMS — MCOs, CVO




- Reduction in duplicative verification processes
