Our friendly library bookworm has picked some hot new titles, this month, which are perfect for warming up the cooling nights. Stop in to check these out soon.

Incredible nonfiction:

"A Woman of No Importance," by Sonia Purnell – Virginia Hall was one of the greatest spies in American history, yet no one has heard of her. Hall hated being the center of attention and was not even acknowledged for her role in winning WWII until after her death. Through meticulous research and detailed journalism, Purnell tells Hall's story.

Fantastic Fiction: (due to be released in Mid-September)

"Apples Never Fall," by Liane Moriarty – The Delaneys are one big happy family—or so it appears. When Mom and Dad let a broken and battered stranger into their home, the tiny cracks in the family's veneer begins to grow larger. Mom is suddenly missing, as is the stranger, and Dad is the prime suspect. Now the four grown children are split down the middle on who's really to blame for Mom's being gone. As they look for answers, the family will also be forced to reexamine their shared family history in a very new light.

Hot reads for Teens and 'Tweens:

"The Endling Trilogy" Books1-3 by Katherine Applegate – Byx is the youngest of her pack, which are members of a mystical, magical dog-like species that has been hunted to near extinction. After the rest of her pack is killed, and Byx fears she is the last, she begins the search for a safe haven. Along the way she meets new allies, animal and human alike, who have their own reasons for joining her quest. The unlikely group faces untold dangers at every turn and finds more than they bargained for along the way.

**Children's Choices:** 

"Fox & Rabbit," by Beth Ferry – In this graphic novel series for young readers, Fox and Rabbit are total opposites, but they are also the perfect match. Young readers can follow them as they discover new favorites and face new challenges and learn that, together, there's nothing they can't do.

#### **Digital Delights:**

"The Hitman's Wife's Bodyguard" (DVD) – Bodyguard Michael Bryce and hitman Darius Kincaid are back on another life-threatening mission. Still unlicensed and under scrutiny, Bryce is forced into action by Darius's even more volatile wife, the infamous international con artist Sonia Kincaid. As Bryce is driven over the edge by his two most dangerous protectees, the trio get in over their heads in a global plot and soon find that they are all that stand between Europe and a vengeful and powerful madman. A cast filled with big-name stars promises action, adventure and thrills!

Teachers and homeschooling parents can also use Teachables, educator-created and expert-vetted teaching materials, such as back-toschool themed activities, social and emotional lessons and printable mini -books for every grade.
