

FROM DO OVER

My neighbor Nate lost his job on a Friday.

If you are ever invited to a late Friday afternoon meeting with your boss, that's not a meeting, that's a booby trap. On par with the time I ate the hot pepper in the Thai soup my wife had made.

As I chewed, tears started to stream down my face and my lips began to feel blistery. My wife asked, "What's wrong?"

I said, "That pepper is trying to murder me!"

She replied, "Why did you eat it? You're not supposed to eat it."

Stuffing slices of bread down my gullet as fast as I could, I shouted, "I eat things that are in bowls at dinner. That's been our arrangement for all 12 years of our marriage. I was unaware that had changed!"

Nate's career quickly changed that day, too. He was suddenly afloat and not by his own choice.

I met with him the next week for coffee.

With a dazed expression he told me how he felt losing a job he'd had for eight years.

He was good at it. He always hit his numbers. People liked him. Clients texted their condolences to him days after it had happened. He was and still is a great guy.

But he was in trouble.

Cocooned for eight years inside a big, safe company, he unexpectedly found himself out on the streets. The career home he had constructed didn't exist any longer and the rest of the world had changed dramatically since he entered the biodome of that job.

With a great sense of exasperation he said, "I don't even know how to use LinkedIn."

No one expects a sudden job change, that's why they are sudden. And if you've been employed for longer than a year, you've seen one happen. Perhaps your seas are clear right now, calm even. Maybe you're not dealing with a big change, you're dealing with something more subtle like a Career Ceiling.

A Career Ceiling is the lid on top of your career ladder. It's the top height any particular job path is going to take you. With two young kids, a mortgage and a fairly new marriage, it is intimidating to stare down 30 years of possible career monotony. I might not be that adventurous, but being "done" career wise at 32 was a jagged little pill to shallow.

When you hit a career ceiling, you used to only have a few options. You could:

1. Get a job at another company.

2. Do a job you didn't want to do, like being a creative director.

3. Suck it up and die inside over a period of roughly 40 years.

The first option doesn't fix things, it just delays them. You might get a different title and more money. That other company might have a "Senior Senior Writer," position but eventually you'll face the same ceiling you faced at your previous job.

In the second option you trade your ladder for a different one and start climbing somewhere else. That's a great option if you have another passion you really want to pursue and there's an opening in your town, in your salary range, in your skill set. That's a lot of ifs though and more often than not, this option isn't going to work out.

The third option is definitely the most depressing but it's also the most popular. That's why in a 2013 Gallup poll, 70% of Americans hated their jobs or felt disengaged. Poke your head up if you're reading this book at work. Seven of the 10 people you can see don't want to be there. No one wants to go back to a job they don't like.

Every one of us will experience a career jump, a career bump or a career ceiling.





FROM ENCOUNTERS WITH JESUS

I was raised in a mainline Protestant church, but in college I went through personal and spiritual crises that led me to question my most fundamental beliefs about God, the world, and myself.

During those years I fell in with some Christians who were active in small-group Bible studies. In these groups the leader would not take the role of teacher or instructor; instead he or she would facilitate the entire group's reading and interpretation of the chosen Bible text. The ground rules were simple but crucial for the integrity of the exercise. The Bible was to be given the benefit of the doubt—the text was to be treated as reliable and its authors as competent. No one person's interpretation was to be imposed on the passage; we were to come to conclusions as a group. We sought to mine the riches of the material as a community, assuming that together we would see far more than any individual could.

Before I was even sure where I stood in my own faith, I was asked to lead a group and was provided with a set of Bible studies entitled Conversations with Jesus Christ from the Gospel of John by Marilyn Kunz and Catherine Schell. It covered thirteen passages in the book of John where Jesus had conversations with individuals. Those studies helped my group uncover layers of meaning and insight that astonished us all. Moving through these accounts of Jesus' life, I began to sense more than ever before that the Bible was not an ordinary book. Yes, it carried the strange beauty of literature from the remote past; but there was something else. It was through these studies of encounters with Jesus that I began to sense an inexplicable life and power in the text. These conversations from centuries ago were uncannily relevant and incisive to me—right now. I began to search the Scriptures not just for intellectual stimulation but in order to find God.


I was taught that patience and thoughtfulness were keys to insight. At one point I went to a conference for Bible study leaders. I'll never forget one of the exercises. The instructor gave us one verse, Mark 1:17 (ESV): "And Jesus said to them, 'Follow me, and I will make you become fishers of men.' "She asked us to spend thirty minutes studying the verse (which, naturally, was taken from an encounter with Jesus). She warned us that after five or ten minutes we would think we had seen all there was to see, but she challenged us to keep going. "Write down at least thirty things you see in or learn from the verse." Ten minutes into the exercise I was finished (or so I thought) and bored. But I dutifully pushed on and kept looking. To my surprise there was more. When we all returned she asked us to look at our list and circle the most penetrating, moving, and personally helpful insight. Then she asked us a question: "How many of you discovered your best insight in the first five minutes? Raise your hands." No hands. "How many after ten minutes?" One or two hands. "Fifteen?" More. "Twenty?" A large number now raised their hands. "Twenty-five?" Many of us now raised our hands, smiling and shaking our heads.

Those initial experiences with patient, inductive study of the biblical text changed my spiritual life. I discovered that if I spent the time and assumed the proper attitude of openness and trust, God spoke to me through his Word. They also set me on my vocational course by giving me the tools to help other people hear God's Word through the Bible. For nearly forty years I've been teaching and preaching the Bible for people, but the basis for every talk, lecture, or sermon has always been what I learned in college about how to sit with a text and carefully plumb its depths.

I still accept the authority of all of the Bible, and love learning and teaching from all of it. But I first felt the personal weight of the Bible's spiritual authority in the Gospels, particularly in those conversations Jesus had with individuals—the skeptical student Nathanael, Jesus' bewildered mother at the wedding feast, the religion professor who came at night, the woman at the well, the bereaved sisters Mary and Martha, and many others.

I suppose you could say that many of my own formative encounters with Jesus came from studying his encounters with individuals in the Gospels.

"You should come back just for you. Not to dance professionally or anything. I think it would be good for you to just dance and move to music. I don't care how you dance or what you look like, and you can take for free as my guest. Just come back."

I gave Nancy a very non-committal answer, but over the next couple of days I could not get the idea out of my head. Maybe it would feel good to dance again with no one pressuring me to do it. And since I was no longer a part of a company, I did not have to worry about what anyone thought about my appearance. My body was now my own.

A few days later, I walked into Nancy's classroom at Steps. I was suddenly terrified to enter the studio and had to talk myself into actually going through with the class. I had to remind myself that I was free from anyone else's judgment, that I was a Daughter of the Lord, and that I was just going in to take a ballet class for fun, for me. But, I still had the remnants of the shame I had been dancing with for years.


The class was like a renewing rain. Even the center work felt good, despite the fact that I was out of shape and could not dance anything very well. It was simply wonderful to dance to music again and I found a freedom in the familiar structure of a ballet class. But, I couldn't look at myself in the mirror. As comfortable as I was growing in my new regular life, in a ballet setting I could not see my reflection without hearing the old voices of disgust and condemnation ringing through my head. So, my solution was to just not look so that I could enjoy dancing again.

After a few days of this, I had a moment in the middle of Nancy's class that was a culmination of all the healing that had slowly been taking place in my life. Nancy was giving the adagio combination in the center and I was in the middle of a group of dancers trying to learn the sequence. The dancers in front of me shifted just enough so that I could see myself in the mirror; I locked eyes with my reflection.

I stared at myself for an uncomfortable moment or two, immediately going into self-hating dancer mode...to find out what was wrong or bad or ugly. We dancers try to perfect the shapes and lines of our body and feel unsatisfied if our feet aren't arched enough or our legs aren't high enough or our arms aren't well shaped. I know some dancers who were told, ridiculously, that their necks were too short. They wear their hair high to try to disguise the "problem", but I am sure that most of the time when they look in the mirror, they think, "Short neck." Me, I stared at my hips and thighs and arms and waist, disgusted by them and ashamed that I had even walked into a ballet class.

But then, like a golden light, a thought fell over me: You are beautiful just the way you are, like this, right now. It was not my thought. It must have come from God. But I saw the truth in it, because I realized that my beauty came not from my body but from the fact that I was a Child of God, redeemed and forgiven. My appearance was not important. I could allow myself to be in this body, exactly the way it was, and feel beautiful and loved by my Savior who had died for me and for all the things about myself that I hated. I could accept God's forgiveness and also forgive myself for falling and failing and self-destroying. New in

The author of more than thirty books, she also writes the Black Sheep Knitting Mysteries under her real name, Anne Canadeo. She lives with her husband and daughter in a small village on the Long Island Sound. Outside of her office, she is active in many community projects, including aiding the homeless, preparing food for those in need, and participating in a literacy outreach program that promotes reading and provides free books.
