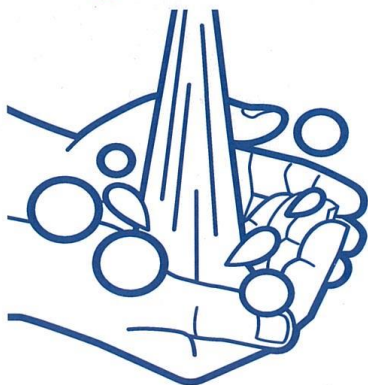

Why check in?

Contact tracing helps stop the spread of COVID-19 in our community. Let's help NSW Health contact tracers by checking in wherever we can, so they can get in touch quickly and easily, if necessary.

This business is required to use the NSW Government QR Code to record contact details for all customers.

How to check in

It's easy to check in with the Service NSW COVID Safe Check-in tool.

Start by scanning the NSW Government QR code with your smartphone camera or QR Code reader app and encouraging everyone you're with to do the same.

Be COVID safe. Check in everyone, every time.

Contact tracing helps stop the spread of COVID-19 in our community. This business is required to use the NSW Government QR Code to record contact details for all customers.

It's easy to check in with the Service NSW COVID Safe Check-in tool.

Scan the NSW Government QR code at the venue with your smartphone's camera or QR code reader app and encourage the people you are with to do the same.

Then:

• If you have the Service NSW app:



You'll automatically be taken to the COVID Safe Check-In tool where you can quickly check in yourself and any dependants (such as children or elderly family members) who are with you.

• If you don't yet have the Service NSW app:

You will be taken to the Service NSW web page with links to download the Service NSW app for either iOS or Android phones from the relevant app stores. Open the Service NSW app, and Sign Up for a MyServiceNSW account - it will mean you can check in as quickly as possible each time. You can also check in using the COVID Safe Check-in tool without a MyServiceNSW account.

Alternatively, you can check in using the webform.

Tap the red 'Webform' button on the Service NSW webpage, and enter your contact details and those of any dependants (if needed).

Once successfully checked in - show your green check-in tick to the staff member.

Don't have a smartphone?

Ask the business to check you in by adding your contact details to their Service NSW Check-in form on their tablet or laptop.

We respect your privacy

When you scan the NSW Government QR Codes, the only personal information sent to Service NSW is your Customer ID (if you have a MyServiceNSW account), your name, phone number, the location of the business and time of visit. The business will not see or collect this information and it will only be used for contact tracing. This information is stored for 28 days.

2021 OPERATION ART EXHIBITION

Every year schools across New South Wales are invited to participate in Operation Art, an initiative of The Children's Hospital at Westmead in association with the New South Wales Department of Education. The Operation Art program provides a forum for schools and students to demonstrate their visual arts achievements through exhibitions at the Armory Gallery, Sydney Olympic Park and the Art Gallery of New South Wales.

Closing date for entries to QPS: 21st May, 2021

Artwork size: Minimum A4 (30 x 21cm), maximum A2 (42 x 60cm), maximum depth 5mm. Please note: Artwork deeper than this limit will not be framed.

Curatorial Brief:

"As some exhibited works will eventually be hung at the Children's Hospital at Westmead, we ask that special consideration be given to ensure that the artwork submitted is uplifting and does not contain material that could be considered culturally sensitive in nature". *Ivy Baddock, Art Curator, The Children's Hospital at Westmead.*

Entry Fee: The fee this year for Government Schools is \$95.00 per artwork. This fee is to be paid by entrants into this competition. Quandialla Public School will assist with entry fees, making the entry fee for QPS students = \$55.00 per artwork.

Artwork Limit: Each school may submit up to four works of art. Please notify the school if you wish to participate in the 2020 Operation Art Exhibition. If more than 4 artworks are received, the school will make the decision on which ones to enter.

For **collaborative works**, a maximum of four (4) students per work may contribute to creating the entry.
