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SUMMER-CLASS TYPE DEFINITION

While we are hoping to return to our regular schedule of instruction for the spring quarter, we are also planning for all possible outcomes. Classes for spring quarter are designated in these five ways:

MODALITIES WITH A FACE-TO-FACE COMPONENT

Face-to-Face: Class times are listed in the schedule. Classes will meet in a **face-to-face** format on campus. Based on the state's response to COVID-19, these courses may shift to virtual, online, or hybrid/virtual using Zoom. Your instructor will let you know prior to the start of fall quarter via your GRC email and Canvas dashboard.

Hybrid: Part of the class will occur in a **face-to-face** format on campus at the time listed in the class schedule. The other part will be held **online** without a set time to attend.

If on-campus instruction is not yet allowed by fall quarter, then the face-to-face part of the course will switch to online or virtual using Zoom or other virtual format. Your instructor will let you know prior to the start of fall quarter via your GRC email and Canvas dashboard.

MODALITIES WITH NO FACE TO FACE COMPONENT

Completely Virtual: Class will meet **online** at the time listed in the class schedule. For example, if your class begins at 9 a.m. in the class schedule, then it will begin at 9 a.m. on Zoom. You will be attending the class at the same time as your classmates, just as you would on campus.

Virtual Hybrid: Part of the class will be held **online** without a set time to attend. The other part will occur at the time listed in a virtual format (e.g. Zoom). Your instructor will let you know prior to the start of fall quarter via your GRC email and Canvas dashboard.

Online: The entire class will be held **online** without a set time to attend. The class will still have assignment deadlines and due dates.

Note: If, due to the state's response to COVID 19, the teaching modality listed in the class schedule changes before the start of fall quarter, students will be notified by their instructor as soon as possible.

How do you get into a class that is full?

Entry codes will not allow you to by-pass the waitlist option and register yourself into a full class. The waitlist process works as follows:

- Web or in-person registration will provide the option to waitlist into a full class. All prerequisites must be met to be added to a waitlist.
- You can add your name to three separate waitlists an example would be math, English and chemistry.
- Cluster classes are moved from the waitlist in the order the students were added.
- Review your schedule every few days via the Web to see if you have been added to the class.
- You are responsible for making sure your schedule is accurate by dropping any unwanted classes. Failure to do so will result in a 0.0 grade being posted to your transcript and possible additional tuition and fees.
- To remove your name from a waitlist:
- 1. Go to greenriver.edu/online
- 2. Select Waitlist manager

You may also stop by Admissions and Registration to request that your name be removed.

- If you have not moved off the waitlist and into the class by the first day of the quarter, you need to attend the first class session and identify yourself to the instructor.
- Attending the first class session will not guarantee admittance into the class.

Students are responsible for the accuracy of their class schedule. If you are registered for a class that you no longer plan to attend, withdraw from the class online or stop by Admissions and Registration.

Registration Information

Residency Requirements, 253-288-3383

The state of Washington has established specific criteria for students to qualify as residents for tuition paying purposes (references: RCW 28B.15 and WAC 250.18).

A resident student is one who is a U.S. citizen, or has permanent or temporary resident status, or holds "Refugee-Parolee" or "Conditional Entrant" status with the United States Immigration and Naturalization Service or is otherwise permanently residing in the United States under color of law; and be either:

- 1. Financially independent student:
 - Have established a bona fide domicile in the state
 of Washington primarily for purposes other than
 education for a period of one year immediately
 before the first day of the quarter for which they
 have registered at any institution; and
 - Be financially independent.

OR

Financially dependent student:
 Be a dependent student with one or both of their parents or legal guardians having maintained a bona fide domicile in the state of Washington for at least one year immediately before the first day of the quarter for which they have registered at any institution.

To apply for residency reclassification, students submit a residency questionnaire and provide the required documentation to the Office of the Registrar. Students may apply for residency reclassification through the 30th calendar day of the quarter. See residency questionnaire for complete details. Residency questionnaires are available online, in the Office of the Registrar, or by calling 253-288-3383

Note these additional points:

- Residence is not an equivalent of domicile only—must also provide documentation supporting student's financial independent or dependent status.
- A student cannot qualify as a legal resident of Washington for tuition calculation purposes if she/ he possesses a valid out-of-state driver's license, vehicle registration, or other documents that give evidence of being a legal resident in another state.
- The domicile of a minor is normally that of the parent or legally appointed guardian.
- International students attending Green River who have been issued an I-20 form are classified as nonresident regardless of length of residency in Washington state.

Nonresident Waiver

The Washington State Board for Community and Technical Colleges has authorized the colleges to waive a portion of the nonresident tuition rate for United States citizens and INS Permanent residents who have not met the above criteria for in-state residency. Green River honors this automatic waiver at the time a student makes application to the college. The student pays the non-Washington resident tuition rate (see chart on page 4).

HB 1079 (Undocumented Person) Waiver

Effective July 1, 2003, Washington state law was changed, presumed undocumented students or non-immigrant visa holders who meet certain criteria are eligible for resident student status and resident tuition rates. To qualify, students who have resided in Washington state for three years immediately prior to receiving a high school diploma and completed the full senior year at a Washington high school or completed the equivalent of a high diploma in Washington State, and complete an affidavit promising to apply for permanent residency in the United States at the earliest possible opportunity and indicating a willingness to engage in activities necessary to acquire citizenship.

Veteran Services, 253-288-3452

Green River College is approved for Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) education benefits. Students who fit VA eligibility criteria may use their education benefits for most of our academic programs. An updated list of approved programs can be found on the VA's website. Full-time enrollment for fall, winter, and spring quarters is 12 credits. Enrollment for Fall terms is based on length of the term elected.

Certification for education benefits will be forwarded to the VA after proof of registration has been received by Veteran Services.

In-state and/or reduced tuition rates may be available to veterans and their spouse and/or dependents that meet specific state requirements. For more information please visit the Office of the Registrar with a copy of your DD 214 and your COE (Certificate of Eligibility).

Veterans may also be eligible for priority registration. Individuals must meet the established eligibility criteria and submit a copy of their DD 214 to the Office of the Registrar.

Withdrawal and Refund Rules

Credit classes

It is the student's responsibility to withdraw from the college or from individual courses. Students must withdraw online or submit a withdrawal/change of schedule form to guarantee the accuracy of their permanent records and to begin refund procedures when applicable. The student may receive a refund under the following conditions:

Percentage of refund

100 percent refund of tuition and fees—When

courses or programs are canceled by the college or when a student officially withdraws from class through the fifth instructional day of the quarter.

40 percent refund of tuition only (No fees will be refunded after the 100% refund period ends)—When official withdrawal occurs after the fifth instructional day of the quarter through the end of the refund period (see next bullet).

No refunds–After the 15th calendar day of the quarter. The 15th calendar day is the end of the refund period.

Short-term classes–100% refund of tuition and fees when official withdrawal occurs prior to the first day of class only. Short-term classes are indicated by dates published with the class listing.

Refunds of less than \$10 will not be made.

Appeals to the withdrawal policy must be submitted to the Office of the Registrar in written form with supporting documents attached.

Withdrawal appeals must be received within one year of the quarter in question.

A separate refund policy applies to students receiving financial aid. Tuition refunds must be returned to the financial aid account and not to the student. A separate refund policy applies to students receiving Military Tuition Assistance (TA).

Withdrawing from classes online Financial Aid:

Students may jeopardize their future financial aid eligibility by dropping classes. Please check with financial aid if you have questions.

International Students:

If you are an F-1 international student and you drop below 12 credits without permission, your SEVIS record and student status through Green River will end.

Running Start:

Withdrawing from class(es) can impact your high school graduation and continued program eligibility. You are responsible for communicating schedule changes with your high school.



MATHEMATICS-LAB MATH RESOURCE MODULES-

Students will be required to keep a log of their activities and must document a minimum of 22 hours to receive one credit, 44 hours for two credits. They will also be required to turn in copies of all work associated with the resources. Two written papers will make up the remainder of the time for the course.
