Ave Maria, Regina Angelorum! Hail Mary, Queen of Angels!

Last month Pope Francis announced this Sunday to be the first world day for grandparents and the elderly. In his message the pope reflects on the last words of Christ to the apostles before his ascension into heaven: I am with you

always (Mt.28:20). The pope reminds us that the Lord is always near, even when we feel isolated and alone. The Lord is with us in His Word, and Pope Francis invites us "to read a page of the Gospel every day, to pray with the psalms, to read the prophets! We will be comforted by the Lord's faithfulness. The Scriptures will also help us to understand what the Lord is asking of our lives today."

Just before this final word of Christ promising to always be present to his Church, the Lord gives us the great commission: to make disciples of all nations, preaching the Gospel everywhere in its fullness (Mt.28:19-20). "These words are also addressed to us today. They help us better understand that our vocation is to preserve our roots, to pass on the faith to the young, and to care for the little ones." This is a call that we must all take up with the hope of Christ's promise to be with us always. Our pope reminds us: "there is no retirement age from the work of proclaiming the Gospel."

May the Lord bless all of our elderly parishioners and give us all an appreciation for those who have gone before us and great hope in his constant presence with us all.


