# THE GOOD NEWS

## FROM DEACON STEVE

Today I'd like to start out my message to you with a definition of a word that I believe touches all of our lives. The word is "vibrant," which can be defined as *pulsating with vigor, energy and vitality; full of life; exciting or stimulating.*

Now for a question. How many of you believe that the word "vibrant" clearly reflects the essence of who we are as a parish community here at Queen of Heaven? Let me see a show of hands. You got it! We indeed are a vibrant parish. Our vibrancy shows in many ways:

- o In our Liturgies where both clergy and laity inspire active participation and offer an experience of God.
- o In the opportunities that are available to us here at the Parish for study, formation and fun, all of which serve to nurture our faith.
- o In our outreach work to the Body of Christ.

Our parish community shines brightly, too, as we cultivate together our baptismal vocational call. Baptism calls each of us to some form of ministry and discipleship. The gifts and graces bestowed on us individually by God throughout our lives invite us to a response of generous hearts and faithful witness as Catholic Christians. But as Catholics we sometimes get a little nervous by that word "witness."

Jesus' Gospel message to each of us, however, is clear,

"You are the light of the world. A city set on a mountain cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and then put it under a basket; it is set rather on a lampstand, where it gives light to all in the house. Just so, your light must shine before others, so that, seeing your good works, they may glorify your heavenly Father."

Note that our Lord uses the phrase "...your light *must* shine..." He's not suggesting here, rather He's commanding that we take what we've graciously been given (the promise of eternal life through Jesus Christ) and go out into the world with that message and make disciples.

We have many opportunities to do just that within the circle of our family, friends, coworkers and neighbors. Most of these opportunities to "let our light shine" come to us by way of the ordinary activities of daily life. But I'd like to suggest to you an extraordinary means by which you can make an eternal difference in someone's life. Yes, this is really evangelizing but evangelizing need not be scary.

Each year, our Parish participates in the Church's Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (or RCIA for short). Through RCIA, those who are not Catholic, whether baptized or not, come together to learn about the Catholic Faith and discern if God is calling them to a life in the Church.

This coming summer, preceding the beginning of our RCIA program in September, we're going to be stepping up our recruiting efforts to bring a greater number of folks into our awesome Catholic Faith. We're counting on each of you to pray about this, and if the Spirit so moves you, "let your light shine before others" by influencing one person to come to the RCIA table. We all know at least one individual who is curious about the Faith. What a great blessing your efforts would be to you, to that person and to our vibrant Catholic community. More information about enrolling in the RCIA program will be coming your way shortly.

As you make the light of Jesus known to the world, may God grant you His peace, His grace, His light and His most holy consolation.

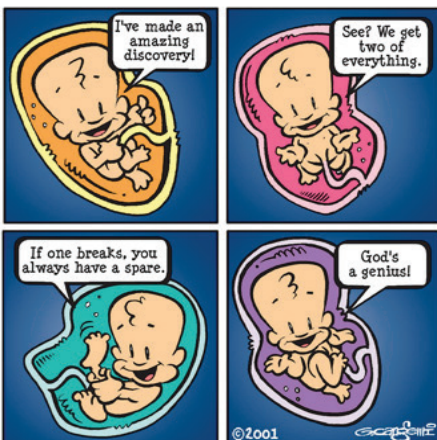

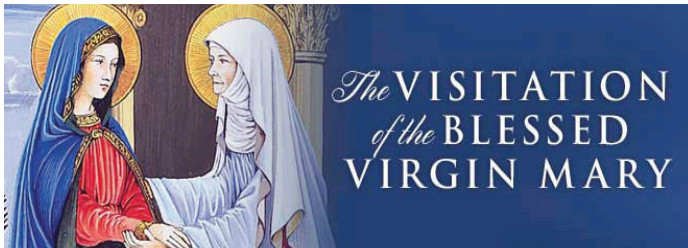
