



- Viewing students at a class or grade level
- Evaluating your core curriculum by domain
- Determining who is most at risk with a particular skill

1. Navigate to Benchmark screen
2. Select grade from the slider bar
3. Select M-CAP
4. Select period
5. Select norms
6. Select “Strengths and Weaknesses” from dropdown menu
7. Select “Common Core” or “aimsweb NCTM”
8. Click Refresh

M-CAP Item Analysis Report (Individual)

- Looking at the individual strengths and weaknesses of a particular student in M-CAP
- Connecting student needs to Pearson’s EnVision Math and Focus Math curriculums

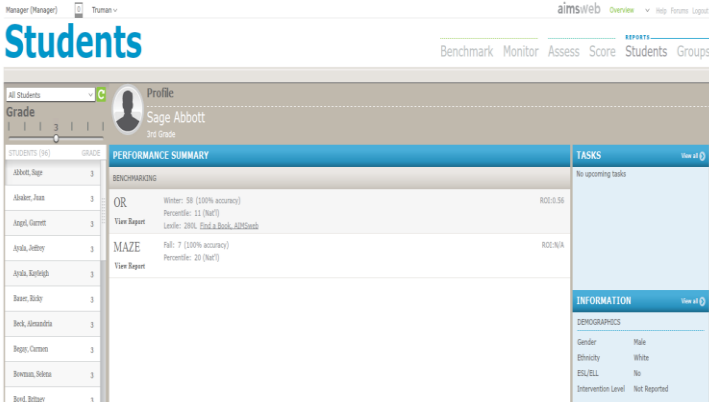
1. Navigate to Students screen
2. Select grade
3. Select student
4. Select view report for M-CAP
5. Choose “Instructional Planning Report” from dropdown menu
6. Click Refresh

Individual Student Report (Bulb Report)

- Visualizing and analyzing a student’s progress over time
- Comparing student to national or local norms
- Sharing with parents

1. Navigate to the Students screen
2. Select grade
3. Select student
4. Click “View Report” for a specific measure
5. Click “Refresh”

Student Profile Report



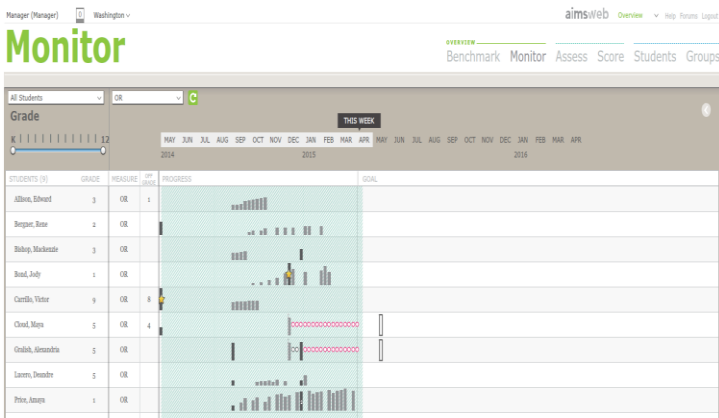
- Looking at data for all measures administered to a particular student
- Links to specific bulb reports for each measure
- Links to the “Find a Book” website to find leveled texts for students
- View and create tasks
- Sharing with parents

1. Navigate to Students screen
2. Select grade
3. Select student
4. Click “Refresh”
5. Information will appear under Performance Summary

2. Select grade from the slider bar
3. Select measure
4. Select period
5. Select norms
6. Select “Benchmark Comparison” from dropdown menu
7. Click “Refresh”
8. Click on Student name
9. Information will appear under Benchmarking

Progress Monitor Caseload Report



- Viewing entire progress monitoring caseload at once
- Filtering list by measure, grade, class, or customized group
- Instantly see students’ progress toward goals with intervention and goal changes, absences and colored indicators
- Click on student name to see student profile to view all measures for a particular student

2. Select grade(s) from the slider bar
3. Click “Refresh”

Individual Progress Monitoring Report



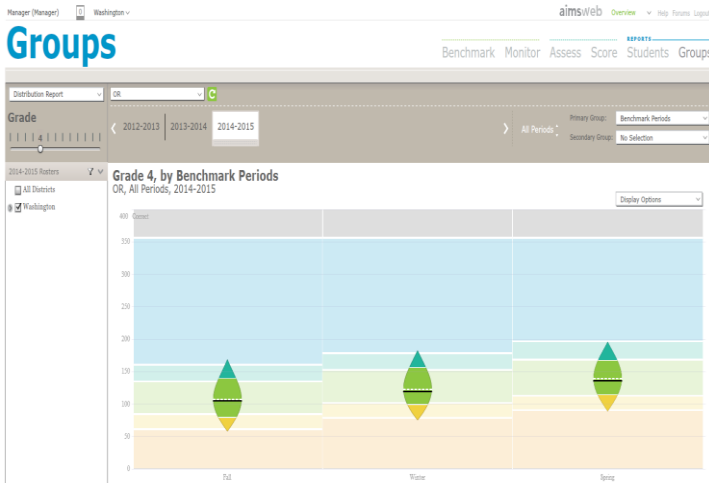
- Viewing students individual response to intervention

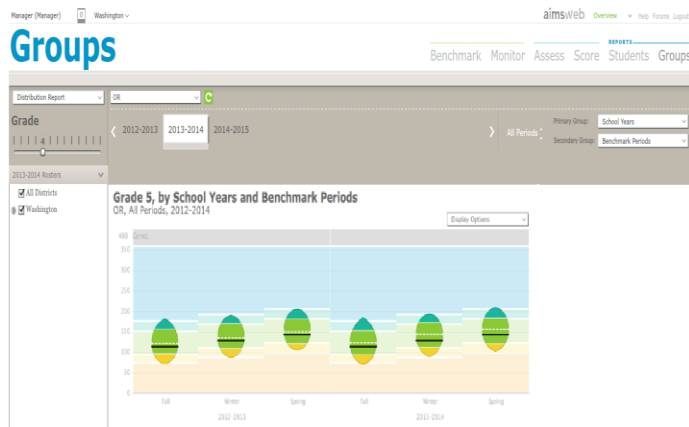
Group Report – Single Grade by Benchmark Periods (Fall, Winter, and Spring)

- Disaggregate across demographics

1. Navigate to Groups screen
2. Select single grade from the slider bar
3. Select measure
4. Select year
5. Select district and/or schools on left under All Districts
6. Select period on the right (Fall, Winter, or Spring) or select All Periods
7. Select Primary Group: Benchmark Periods
8. Click Refresh

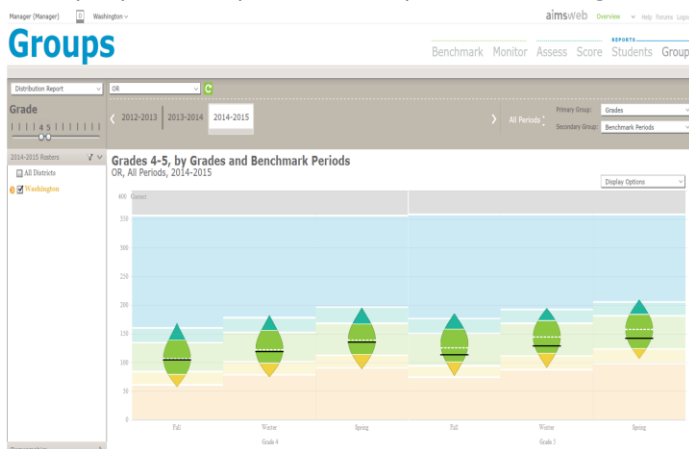
Group Report – Single Grade and Multiple Year by Benchmark Periods (Fall, Winter, and Spring)

- Disaggregate across demographics

7. Choose Primary Group: School years
8. Choose Secondary Group: Benchmark Periods
9. Click "Refresh"

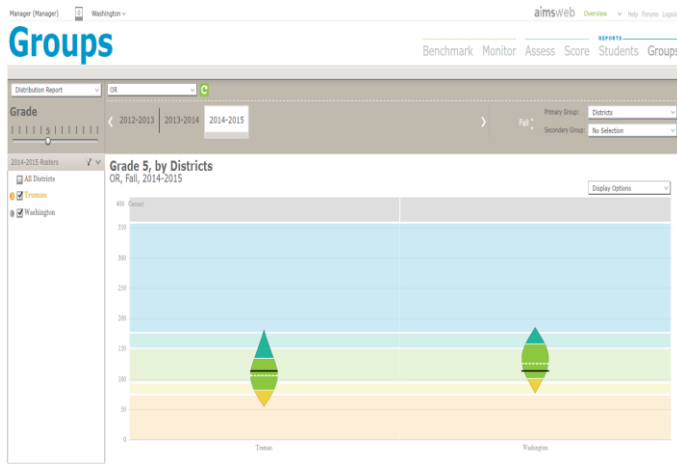
Group Report – Multiple Grades, Multiple Periods, and Single Year

8. Choose Secondary Group: Benchmark Periods
9. Click "Refresh"

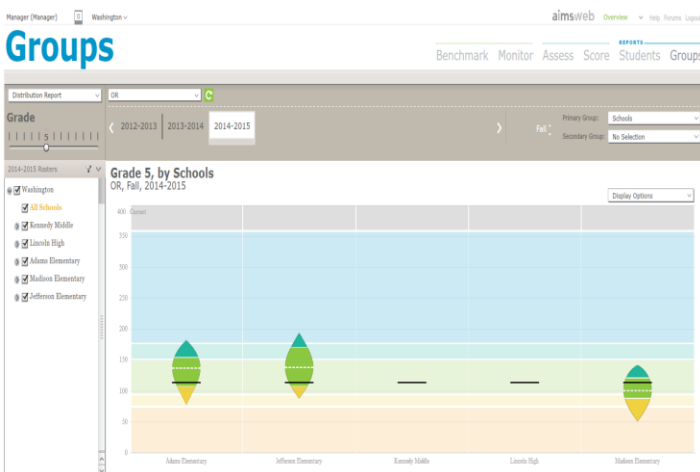
Group Report – Multiple Districts, Single Grade, and Single Period

7. Choose Primary Group: Districts
8. Click “Refresh”

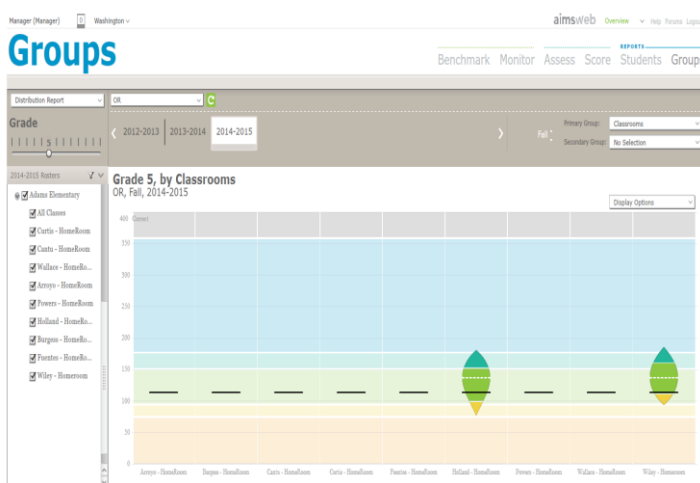
Group Report – Single District, Multiple Schools, Single Grade, and Single Period



- Evaluating performance across multiple schools within a single district, grade, measure, year, and benchmark period
- Disaggregate across demographics

1. Navigate to Groups screen
2. Select year
3. Select Schools on left under District
4. Select grade from the slider bar
5. Select measure
6. Select Period (either Fall, Winter, or Spring)
7. Choose Primary Group: Schools
8. Click “Refresh”

Group Report – Single District, School, Period, Grade, with Multiple Classrooms



- Evaluating performance across multiple classrooms within a single school, grade, measure, year and benchmark period
- Disaggregate across demographics

1. Navigate to Groups screen
2. Select year
3. Select Teacher Homerooms
4. Select grade from the slider bar
5. Select measure
6. Select Period (either Fall, Winter, or Spring)
7. Choose Primary Group: Classrooms
8. Click “Refresh”
