2020 QUILT SHOW
Paint Chip Quilt Challenge

Show theme: Rhapsody in Blue

Size Range: From 12" x 12" min. to 36" x 36" max.

May be any shape: square, rectangle, round, or irregular, as long as it is within size parameters.

Participants will be given an envelope containing paint chips to be matched in fabric.

Colors must be the blues in envelope and white. You may do just blues and whites, or you may add <u>one</u> other contrasting and/or complementary color. You can choose your quilt style: traditional, modern, art. It may be pieced, appliqued, thread painted, embellished, whatever technique you would like to employ. It does need to fit the standard definition of a quilt (top & bottom with batting sandwiched between the two layers, with all three layers sewn [quilted] together). A 4" sleeve must be attached to back, per quilt show rules.

Think about what our theme – Rhapsody in Blue – means to you and try to tie that into your quilt design.

There is a \$5.00 non-refundable fee which covers entry fee, label, and awards ribbons.


