



1 Leech






Suspended thing





Blood clot






Similarity leech and an embryo

We may find similarity comparing a **leech** to an embryo









Also, the embryo at this stage obtains nourishment from the blood of the mother, similar to the leech, which feeds on the blood of others.


Similarity suspended thing and an embryo

The second meaning of the word alaqah is "suspended thing."





We can see the suspension of the embryo, during the alagah stage, in the womb (uterus) of the mother.





Embryo size is **0.6mm**

Similarity of a blood clot and an embryo

We can find that the external appearance of the **embryo** and its sacs during the *alaqah* stage is similar to a blood clot.







Diagram of the primitive cardiovascular system in an embryo during the alaqah stage



This is due to the presence of relatively **large amounts** of **blood** present in the embryo during this stage.



So the three meanings of the word alagah correspond accurately to the descriptions of the embryo at the alagah stage.

Arabic word *mudghah* means "chewed substance."

Professor Keith L. Moore—Embryology professor said:


"If one were to take a piece of gum and chew it in his or her mouth...

...and then compare it with an embryo at the mudghah stage...

...we would conclude that the embryo at the mudghah stage acquires the appearance of a chewed substance."

This is because of the **somites** at the back of the embryo that somewhat resemble **teethmarks** in a chewed substance.


Chewed bubble gum


