"Foreigner" is the term resonating with me this afternoon as I sit here preparing this article. You see I have been reading a chapter a day out of the New Testament with my dlife group, and this week we find ourselves in I Peter. Throughout his first letter Peter reminds us we are "strangers" and "pilgrims", or "foreigners and temporary residents" as one translation puts it, and in so doing gives us instructions on how we are to live in such an environment. An environment that is full of trials, in which we are to remain strong and endure with patience, for the wonderful joy that awaits us.

Peter admonishes us with several things we must do. First, we must live as God's obedient children. We cannot allow ourselves to slip back into our past sinful lifestyles.
