Recruiting Calendar

The current recommendations submitted to the NCAA in April 2012

- As a result of discussions/straw votes taken at the 2011 NFCA National Convention and of subsequent surveys conducted following the convention, the Division 1 membership voted overwhelmingly in support of a structured recruiting calendar
- Proposed recruiting periods
 - Off Campus Contact & Evaluation Periods
 - Thursday following the WCWS through August 15
 - October 1 through Sunday prior to Thanksgiving (Saturday's & Sunday's only)
 - Contact Only Periods
 - Aug 16 through September 30th
 - Monday prior to Thanksgiving through the end of WCWS
 - Dead periods
 - Monday through Thursday of the week that includes the initial date for the fall signing of the NLI
 - The Wednesday prior to Thanksgiving though the Friday following Thanksgiving
 - The Day prior to the start of the NFCA convention through 12:01 am on the day following the convention
 - Dec 24-26
 - Monday through Thursday of the week that includes the initial date for the spring signing of the NLI
 - First day of the NCAA Division 1 WCWS thorough 12:01 am on the day following the championship game
- Additional proposals relating to the adoption of the recruiting calendar
 - During a contact period only, Division 1 coaches are restricted to being employed at institutional camps & clinics when the camp or clinic includes prospective student athletes
 - Institutional camps held during a contact only period must be held within 100 mile radius of that institution's main campus
 - Non-scholastic softball competition that involves PSA's may not occur on an institutions campus

Recruiting Calendar

Revisiting the current recommendations for future consideration by the NCAA

 In anticipation that the NCAA is going to lift the moratorium on new legislation, now is the time to revisit/change the standing recommendations proposed to the NCAA in April of 2012

- What has changed
 - 3 coaches can recruit
 - Technology
- The membership voted overwhelmingly that we want a more structured calendar. The following talking points were established to facilitate the debate on finding a good balance between focusing on off-campus evaluations and focusing on all other aspects of running a Division 1 softball program

Fall Recruiting Period

(possible structural options)

Option 1

 Contact period only: Tuesday following labor day through the end of WCWS

Option 2

 Contact/evaluation period: 3rd Friday in October through the Tuesday prior to Thanksgiving

Fall Recruiting Period – Option 1

(Contact period only: Tuesday following labor day through the end of the WCWS)

<u>Pro</u>

- Allows for more time on campus
 - Develop own team
 - Community service projects
 - On campus recruiting can increase
- Requires a smaller budget
- Creates a clear system that states when D1 coaches are allowed to have off-campus evaluations
- Creates a more equitable system for quarter schools
- Creates a more equitable system for colder weather states
- Enforceable
- PSA welfare issues
 - Reduces missed class time
 - Reduction in overuse injuries
 - Reduces personal spending
 - Gives PSA's an off season from off-campus evaluations

Con

 Coaches who have been newly hired might feel the need to use the fall to catch up

Fall Recruiting Period – Option 2

Contact/Evaluation Period: 3rd Friday in October through Tuesday prior to Thanksgiving

Pro

- Creates a clear system that states when D1 coaches are allowed to have offcampus evaluations
- Enforceable
- Allows for more time on campus for semester schools
 - Develop own team
 - Community service projects
 - On campus recruiting can increase

Con

- PSA welfare issues
 - Increases missed class time
 - Increase in overuse injuries
 - Increases personal spending
 - Doesn't Give PSA's an off-season from off-campus evaluations
- Creates an unfair system for quarter schools
- Creates an unfair system for colder weather states

Winter/Spring Recruiting Period

 Non-recruiting period beginning the Wednesday before Thanksgiving through the end of the WCWS

Summer Recruiting Period

(Contact/Evaluation period: The day following the WCWS through Labor day)

Pro

- Creates a clear system that states when Division 1 coaches are allowed to recruit
- Enforceable
- Flexible

Con

- Increases the number of evaluation days
- Requires a larger budget
