Apply for a Job in MWE via Job Number Search

You've found a job you are interested in applying for and have a MWE Job Order #, so what's the next step? From your MWE dashboard, click the **Job Search** button under the Job Seeker Services Section. Next, click the **Job Search Number** button, enter the MWE Job Order # provided and click **search**. Select the desired position to view the *Job Summary* section. This section contains details about the job, such as address, date of posting, and positions available. There are also summary icons that display basic details, such as salary, access to public transportation, minimum experience, and education level.

View the full job description and if you meet the minimum requirements and you are interested in applying, click the **How to Apply for this Job** button near the bottom of the screen.

This page lists the application methods you may choose from. Click the **Apply via Resume** button.

Next, select your resume you previously uploaded in your MWE profile, from the drop-down list. You also have the option to create a new resume or change information on your selected resume before sending it to the employer.

When employers create job postings, they can specify what information is required when you apply for the job. This section displays the information required by this employer for you to apply.

Items that have a green checkmark in the required field is information you have already provided. Items that are marked with a red X require you to add the information. Click the **Edit** link to add information for these sections. All items in this section must display green check marks before you can apply for this job.

You can attach a cover letter to your job application from the drop-down list, or click the **Create Cover Letter** link to create a new cover letter. Attaching a cover letter is optional.

After you have provided all of the required information, click the **checkbox** to acknowledge that you are providing your contact information to the employer posting this job. Then click the **Submit Application** button to finish applying for this job. You will receive a summary of the information that was sent to the Employer.

JOBSEEKER TIP

How to Set Up a Job Search Email Account

When you're looking for a job, it's a good idea to set up an email account just for job searching. That way your professional email won't get mixed in with your personal mail.

Free Email Accounts

There are a variety of free web-based <u>email services</u>, like Gmail and Yahoo, that you can use. You'll be able to check your email online from any computer, so using web mail is a good way to stay on top of your job search.

Do be sure you have an email account name that is appropriate for business use i.e. firstname.lastname@gmail.com not cutegirl@hotmail.com. Once you've set up the account send a few test messages to make sure you can send and receive mail.

Then use this email account for all your job search communications - to apply for jobs, post your resume, and connect with your contacts. Be sure to check your email frequently so you can respond immediately to employers who are interested in hiring you.

Your Work Email Account

Don't use your work email address for job searching or networking.

Don't send resumes and cover letters from your work email account or use that email address when you apply for jobs online. Many companies monitor email communications and you don't want to get caught job searching from work.
