North Barrington Residents Raise Awareness for Violence in Schools

NORTH BARRINGTON RESIDENTS, Kerri and Kevin Tenbrunsel, felt compelled to make a difference after the tragic shootings at Sandy Hook Elementary School on December 14, 2012. Kevin, along with Musical Director and Producer Chris Errera, co-founded Chicago Musicians Care (CMC), an organization that raises money and awareness of the violence that is occurring in schools. Kevin and Errera pulled together Chicago musicians, a number of them being from North Barrington, to record the song "Hallelujah- A Gift to Sandy Hook." All of the proceeds from the song go to the Sandy Hook United Way Fund. CMC had the opportunity to promote the project on WGN Radio, WGN-TV, WBEZ, and The Dolly McCarthy Show. CMC's goal is threefold: to send a message that Chicago has not forgotten the Sandy Hook tragedy; to create awareness around the violence that is occurring in schools; and to raise money for the Sandy Hook Workers Assistance Fund.
