### AP CAPSTONE CURRICULUM (By application to cohort ONLY – open to juniors)

AP Capstone is a program developed by the College Board. It consists of a two-year high school program and two courses: the AP Seminar (junior year) and the AP Research (senior year) courses. Students who successfully

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complete the program and obtain scores of 3 or higher on at least four other AP exams receive either an AP Capstone Diploma or an AP Capstone Certificate.
