  3. M1310 Wound Length
  4. M1312 Width
  5. M1314 Depth

# The New OASIS C1 ICD-9 Version

- 5 Changes to Questions
  1. M1032 > M1033 (**Risk for Hospitalization**)
  2. M1040 > M1041 (**Influenza Vaccine Data Collection Period**)
  3. M1045 > M1046 (**Influenza Vaccine Received**)
  4. M1050 > M1051 (**Pneumococcal Vaccine**)
  5. M1055 > M1056 (**Reason Pneumococcal Vaccine not received**)

Which of the following signs or symptoms characterize this patient as at risk for hospitalization? (Mark all that apply.)

# The New OASIS C<sub>1</sub> ICD-9 Version

OASIS C – M1032	OASIS C <sub>1</sub> - M1033
1 - Recent decline in mental, emotional, or behavioral status	1 - History of falls (2 or more falls - or any fall with an injury - in the past 12 months)
2 - Multiple hospitalizations (2 or more) in the past 12 months	2 - Unintentional weight loss of a total of 10 pounds or more in the past 12 months
3 - History of falls (2 or more falls - or any fall with an injury - in the past year)	3 - Multiple hospitalizations (2 or more) in the past 6 month
4 - Taking five or more medications	4 - Multiple emergency department visits (2 or more) in the past 6 months
5 - Frailty indicators, e.g., weight loss, self-reported exhaustion	5 - Decline in mental, emotional, or behavioral status in the past 3 months

**Collection Period:** Does this episode of care (SOC/ROC to Transfer/Discharge) include any dates on or between October 1 and March 31?

0 - No	0 - No [Go to M1051]
1 - Yes	1 - Yes
NA - Does not apply because entire episode of care (SOC/ROC to Transfer/Discharge) is outside this influenza season.

## 3. M1045 > M1046 Influenza Vaccine

**Received:** Did the patient receive the influenza vaccine for this year's flu season?

# The New OASIS C1 ICD-9 Version

OASIS C – M1045	OASIS C1 - M1046
1 - Received from another health care provider (e.g., physician)	1 - Yes; received from your agency during this episode of care (SOC/ROC to Transfer/Discharge)
2 - Received from your agency previously during this year's flu season	2 - Yes; received from your agency during a prior episode of care (SOC/ROC to Transfer/Discharge)
3 - Offered and declined	3 - Yes; received from another health care provider (for example physician, pharmacist)
4 - Assessed and determined to have medical contraindication(s)	4 - No; patient offered and declined
5 - Not indicated; patient does not meet age/condition guidelines for influenza vaccine	5 - No; patient assessed and determined to have medical contraindication(s)
6 - Inability to obtain vaccine due to declared shortage	6 - No; not indicated - patient does not meet age/condition guidelines for influenza vaccine
7 - None of the above	7 - No; inability to obtain vaccine due to declared shortage

*On OASIS Transfer/Discharge...*

**5. M1055 > M1056 Reason Pneumococcal Vaccine not received:** If patient has never received the pneumococcal vaccination (for example, pneumovax), state reason

# The New OASIS C1 ICD-9 Version

- 1 New Question

On OASIS Transfer/Discharge...

**M1309 Worsening in Pressure Ulcer Status since**

**SOC/ROC:** For Stage II, III and IV pressure ulcers, report the number that are new or have increased in numerical stage since the most recent SOC/ROC



# The New OASIS Assessment Submission and Processing (ASAP) system

- HHAs no longer submit OASIS assessment data to CMS via their state databases
- To access the OASIS ASAP system, you will need a QIES / HHA User ID.
- OASIS submission system will shut down at 6:00 p.m. ET on December 26, 2014
- OASIS ASAP system will be available at 12:00 a.m. ET on January 1, 2015.

# Final Rule Changes:

## Face-to-Face Encounter documentation

- Effective 1/1/2015
- Physician no longer needs to provide a narrative explaining why a patient is eligible for home health.
- Physician must still document clinical conditions causing the patient to be homebound.

# Final Rule Changes: Therapy Re-Evaluation Requirements

- Effective 1/1/2015
- Eliminated: Re-Assessment requirement on the 13th and 19th visit
- New: A functional reassessment by a qualified therapist from each therapy discipline involved in a patient's care every 30 calendar days.

# ICD-10

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- Officially goes into effect on October 1, 2015
- OASIS-C1/ ICD-9 Version will change to OASIS-C1/ ICD-10 Version on October 1, 2015
- To accommodate the new Mo questions:
  - M1010 will change to M1011
  - M1016 will change to M1017
  - M1020/1022 will change to 1021/1023
