

HT1 – Whole School Behaviour Breakdown


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88% of whole school behaviour was positive ⁽²⁾ HT1

HT2 – Whole School Behaviour Breakdown






HT4 – Whole School Behaviour Breakdown

25/2/2019 - 5/4/2019 -




93% of whole school behaviour was positive [©] HT4

A grand total of 199,688 ^(c) SPAR points have been awarded so far this academic year:


- 35,764 points awarded for positive 'On task' behaviour in class
- 49,784 points awarded for **Good work** in class
- 26,285 points awarded for **Star student** in class
- 25,056 points awarded for **Good progress** in class
- 16,742 points awarded for **Positive Engagement** in class
- 10,760 points awarded for **Excellent uniform standards**
- 12,580 points awarded for **Enthusiasm for a task** in class
- 13,132 points awarded for **Excellent contribution** in class
- 9,585 points awarded for other positive behaviours



Key Actions – Academic Year 2018-19:

- 2. Pupil Voice re rewards gathered via Student Council in Autumn term, which called for the following actions:
 - Weekly 'Treat Friday' to be awarded by FT
 - More 'instant' rewards made available e.g. vouchers, raffle prizes, lunch passes etc.
 - A local annual reward trip offer for pupils
 - Greater recognition for consistently outstanding behaviour.

- * A 4 week monitoring period took place for pupils with specific attendance or behavioural concerns.





Rewarding Success at The Barlow

Short Term Rewards:

- 1. Weekly HOY/FT Reward for family group achieving most SPAR points.
- 2. Weekly Reward for family group achieving 100% attendance.

3. Weekly Barlow Star receives Treat Friday via family tutor for going the 'extra Barlow mile'.

4. Introduction of weekly Top 5 SPAR point pupils Spring Term – shared in assembly and entered in to a half-termly prize draw.

Rewarding Success at The Barlow

Medium Term Rewards:

- 1. Half-termly rewards for Top 5 SPAR point pupils prizes for Top 3 and Top 5 attend a half-termly VIP breakfast with Head Teacher.
- 2. Each term pupils can earn one of the following awards:
- Bronze award
- Silver award
- Gold award
- Platinum award
- Attendance awards for pupils with 96%+
- 3. 100% Attendance badges awarded to eligible pupils each term bronze, silver, gold
- 4. Subject awards given twice per year via school Rewards assembly and at annual Awards Ceremony at Stockport Town Hall.

Rewarding Success at The Barlow Long Term Rewards:

- 1. Invitation to Annual Reward trip based on fixed criteria for Attendance, Behaviour and SPAR points –
 - 2019 477 eligible pupils
 - 2018 320 pupils eligible
 - 2017 280 pupils eligible
 - 2016 268 pupils eligible
- 2. Annual Award Ceremony at Stockport Town Hall Tuesday July 2nd.
- 3. Y8 Graduation Ceremony Date TBC
