Fellowships

BCG MBA Fellows Scholarship An opportunity for those beginning their MBA program to get to know BCG and what makes us unique. The scholarship program includes: Monetary awards for top applicants, individual mentorship by BCG consultants, and access to BCG events and case presentations.
