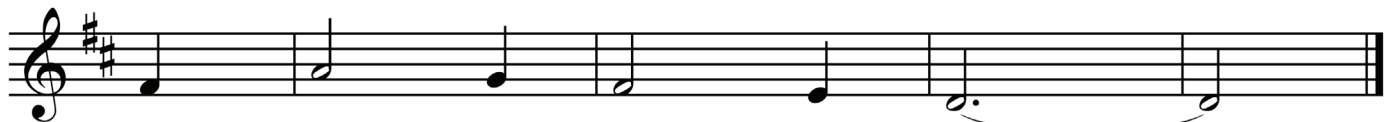

Litany of the Saints

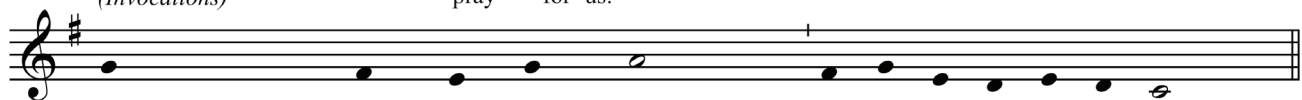
The candidates lie prostrate before the altar as a sign of their humble submission to God's will and so that the assembly, in communion with all the saints, may pray for them.



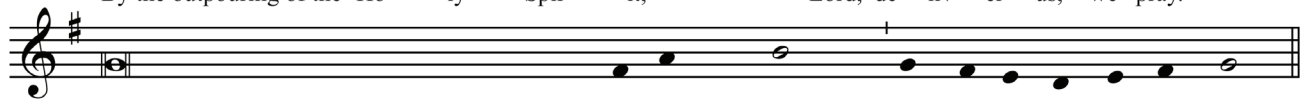

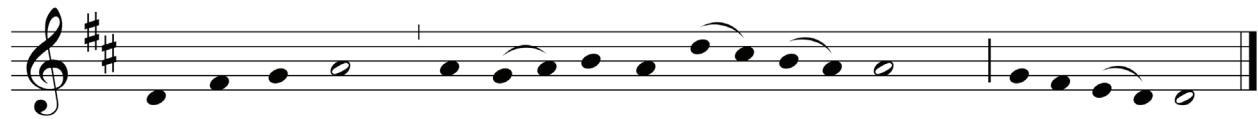

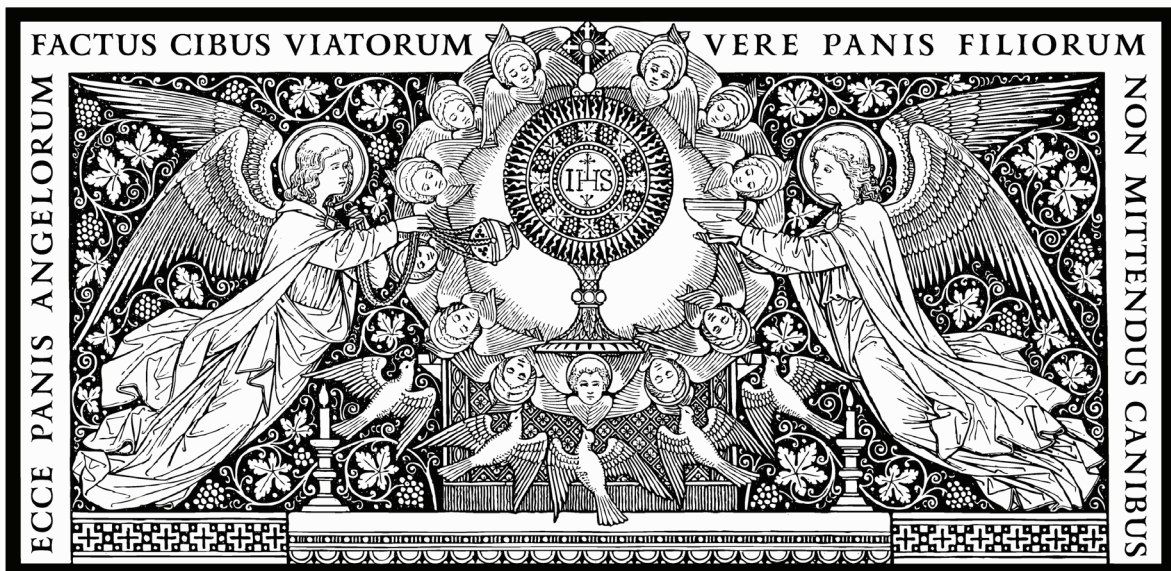
