
Thank you for all who came to Meadowbrook and hope they enjoyed the performance as much as we did!!

Buicktown Chapter's board of directors had the pleasure of meeting Todd Slisher at a formal introduction to the Flint Community on Tuesday, May 20 at the Sloan Museum. In our brief discussion it was obvious he was enthusiastic to hear of the various ways the Buicktown Chapter has supported the museum over the years beginning way back to 1972. He was well informed on the 1953 Skylark restoration progress and strongly supports getting the restoration completed. He invited representatives from our chapter to meet with him to further understand our organization and discuss future activity which may be beneficial to both the museum and our chapter.

Todd graduated with honors from the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor with degrees in astronomy and physics. He is continuing his education at Wayne State University pursuing a Masters in Public Administration. He has a passion for communication so others may understand the many facets of astronomy, the equipment used and application of such knowledge upon the world's social and commercial ventures. Todd has authored and co-authored many papers, articles, documentaries and planetarium shows related to this field of interest. He has successfully achieved significant grant monies for his prior employers. He has managed planetariums in other states and taught college courses on this subject. Recently, he had been employed at the Detroit Science Center, now renamed the Michigan Science Center, an educational institution for youth with a commitment to science, technology, engineering and math. As Director of Visitor Experiences, he directed three separate departments for operations, staffing and budgets. This venue has attracted about 300,000 visitors per year.

We look forward to our future association with Todd and his staff at the museum and Buick Gallery. We will continue to enjoy our cars and club events as we focus, together, on Buick history including artifacts, vehicles, organization and the people of Buick Motor Company.
