Then cross the Danube river to arrive in Bulgaria, where you'll get to experience ancient Veliko Tarnovo; visit Plovdiv, one of the oldest cities in Europe; and take in a panoramic sightseeing drive of Sofia.

# Day 1 Australia - Bucharest, Romania

Today depart from Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, or Adelaide for Bucharest, Romania. Fly with either Etihad Airways, Emirates, British Airways or Singapore Airlines to name a few (subject to availability).

## **Day 2 Welcome to Bucharest!**

Upon arrival into Bucharest you will be met and transferred to the hotel.

Overnight: Hotel Capitol or similar, Bucharest Meals included: None

# **Day 3 Bucharest City Tour**

Today enjoy a full day city tour of Bucharest. Start with a panoramic drive around the main sights such as the Arch of Triumph, Victoria Square, Victoria Avenue and then enjoy a guided visit of the Village Museum. After lunch (not included) enjoy a guided tour through the beautiful old town area, where sights such as Manuc's Inn and the Princely Court are located. Afterwards transfer back to the hotel and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Overnight: Hotel Capitol or similar, Bucharest Meals included: Breakfast

## Day 4 Bucharest - Sibiu, Transylvania

After breakfast check out and depart Bucharest, headed for the Transylvanian city of Sibiu. On the way, visit the monastery at Curtea de Arges – the resting place of the Romanian Royal family. A short drive further on the scenic Transfagarasan Mountain road and you will arrive at a vantage point to see the ruins of the 14th century Poenari Castle. Upon arrival in Sibiu, you will check into the hotel, then enjoy a short guided walk of Sibiu's Old Town. Afterwards return to the hotel and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Overnight: Hotel Golden Tulip Ana Tower or similar, Sibiu Meals included: Breakfast

## **Day 5 Sighisoara Day Trip**

Today enjoy a day trip to the city of Sighisoara which is located on the Tarnava Mare River and is the birthplace of Vlad the Impaler. On the way visit the Biertan Fortified Church, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Upon arrival into Sighisoara enjoy a guided walk in the beautiful Old Town area which is also listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site and visit the Clock Tower Museum and the Arms Museum. This afternoon return to Sibiu and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Overnight: Hotel Golden Tulip Ana Tower or similar, Sibiu Meals included: Breakfast

## Day 6 Sibiu - Cluj-Napoca

This morning check out of the hotel and travel towards northern Romania. On the way enjoy a short stop in the city of Alba Lulia, which is home to an impressive Vauban style fortress, and enjoy a guided walk of the fortress.

Afterwards continue onwards to the Turda Salt Mines - an astonishing complex of underground salt mines where you can





learn the history of salt mining from ancient days to modern times.

Finish the day in Cluj-Napoca a city in northwestern Romania and the unofficial capital of the Transylvanian region.

Overnight: Ramada Cluj or similar, Cluj-Napoca Meals included: Breakfast

## Day 7 Cluj-Napoca - Vadu Izei

Today travel north to the area known as the Maramures. A geographical, historical and cultural region in northern Romania and western Ukraine that is widely regarded as Romania's most traditional region. Dotted with steepled wooden churches and farmhouses fronted by ornately carved gates, Maramures feels as if you are climbing into a horse-drawn time machine and heading back a couple of centuries. On the way drive by the wooden church at Surdesti, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and, until recently, the tallest wooden church in the world. Continue your drive along the scenic Mara Valley, famous for villages where many of the ornate wooden gates can be seen. Upon arrival into the small village of Vadu Izea, check into a traditional family-run Romanian guesthouse, where you will stay for the next two days. Tonight enjoy a home cooked Romanian dinner and the remainder of the evening at leisure.

Overnight: Pensiuni Teleptean or similar, Vadu Izea Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

# **Day 8 Maramures Full Day Tour**

Today enjoy a full day of exploring the beautiful region that is Maramures. Visit a local market, the Sapanta Merry Cemetery, and discover more of the regions iconic wooden architecture. In the afternoon, visit the Memorial Museum which pays

respects to the victims of communism in Sighetu Marmatiei. In the late afternoon or early evening, enjoy a Romanian cooking workshop where you will learn some traditional recipes. Finish the day with an exclusive Romanian folk show with music and dances from the Maramures region followed by another delicious home cooked dinner.

Overnight: Pensiuni Teleptean or similar, Vadu Izea Meals included: Breakfast; Dinner

## Day 9 Maramures - Gura Humorului

This morning leave Maramures and head for the Bucovina region. Along the way, visit the astounding Barsana Monastery with its impressive 'leud' wooden church which is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is believed to be the oldest wooden church in Romania. Afterwards, continue your journey across the Carpathians over the Borgo Pass and stop for photos in the small village of Ciocanesti, famous for its ornate wooden houses, before arriving in Gura Humorului this afternoon. Check in and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Overnight: Hotel Casa Humor or similar, Gura Humorului Meals included: Breakfast

# Day 10 Voronet and Sucevita Monasteries - Marginea Pottery Workshop

Today enjoy a full day spent exploring the famous painted monasteries of Voronet and Sucevita (all listed as UNESCO World Heritage sites).

Also known as the 'the Sistine Chapel of the East' due to its splendid frescoes, the church of the Monastery of Voronet was built in just a couple of months, in 1488, by Stephen the Great, the most popular prince of Moldavia, after one of his victories against the Ottoman armies. This was a common practice





of the prince who promoted an architecture known as the Moldavian style. Many of the churches built this way are still preserved to this day in the regions of Moldavia and Bucovina. Exquisite testimonies of their painters' talent, the frescoes of Voronet conserve a centuries old secret. The distinct 'Voronet blue' colour is unique in the world, and its composition is almost impossible to replicate today.

Afterwards travel onwards to a local black pottery workshop in the nearby village of Marginea where you will discover the ancient art of egg painting. Painted Easter eggs are art objects in Romania, a tradition that goes back hundreds of years, using dazzling combinations of symbols and colours.

Overnight: Hotel Casa Humor or similar, Gura Humorului Meals included: Breakfast

## Day 11 Gura Humorului - Bicaz Gorges - Brasov

Today leave Gura Humorului and return back towards
Transylvania. On the way enjoy a stop at the Nicolae Popa
Ethnographical Museum. Housed in the home of where the
artist, one of the most valued and appreciated naive sculptors
of Romania and a true creator of folklore, used to live, the
museum offers a great opportunity to learn more about the
folk traditions of the area. Continue your journey through the
picturesque Bicaz Gorge before arriving in the beautiful city of
Brasov which is ringed by the stunning Carpathian Mountains.
Upon arrival check in and enjoy the remainder of the day at
leisure.

Overnight: Ambient Hotel or similar, Brasov Meals included: Breakfast

## **Day 12 Brasov Full Day City Tour**

Today enjoy a full day tour of Brasov, beginning with a guided

walk in the Old Town area, with visits to sites such as St. Nicholas's Church, where you can also visit the First Romanian School, the Catherine Gate, Rope Street, the Black Church and the Council Square. In the afternoon, visit one the most famous sights in all of Romania - Bran Castle (a.k.a. Dracula's Castle). Upon arrival in Bran, join your guide for a tour of the castle, then you may spend some time in the shopping area next to the castle, where you can pick up some local souvenirs and also taste locally made products, such as the plum brandy (palinka) famous in the region, and various types of hams and cheese.

Overnight: Ambient Hotel or similar, Brasov Meals included: Breakfast

## Day 13 Brasov - Sinaia - Bucharest

After breakfast check out and leave Brasov heading for Sinaia, where you will visit the magnificent former summer residence of the Romanian Royal family - Peles Castle along with the Sinaia Monastery. Enjoy lunch at leisure (not included) before returning to Bucharest in the afternoon. Check into the hotel and enjoy one last evening at leisure in Romania.

Overnight: Hotel Capitol or similar, Bucharest Meals included: Breakfast

## Day 14 Bucharest, Romania - Veliko Tarnovo, Bulgaria

Today check out and leave the Romanian capital, headed south for the neighbouring country of Bulgaria. You will cross the Danube River, which forms most of the border between the 2 countries and arrive at the town of Ruse, Bulgaria. Enjoy a quick stop in the port town of Ruse with its charming pedestrian area then continue onwards to Veliko Tarnovo, a medieval capital and cultural centre of the Second Bulgarian Empire. Upon arrival enjoy a guided tour of the Old Town





area, where you'll find delightful handcraft shops offering demonstrations of icon painting, woodcarving, textile arts, and traditional metalworking and take the opportunity to savour a cup of Turkish coffee brewed over hot sand (not included), just as it was done in times long past.

Next take a short drive to the nearby village of Arbanassi, an architectural gem of the 1600s and 1700s brought to prominence by the patronage of an Ottoman sultan. This is where rich and powerful merchants of the past lived out their lives.

Catch a glimpse of the Konstantsalieva House, home of one of the wealthiest merchants of the 18th century and discover the Nativity Church, built at a time when Christian architecture in Bulgaria was heavily restricted by the Ottomans. Return to Veliko Tarnovo and enjoy an evening at leisure.

Overnight: Hotel Panorama or similar, Veliko Tarnovo Meals included: Breakfast

## **Day 15 Veliko Tarnovo - Plovdiv**

Today check out after breakfast and embark on a scenic journey that will take you over the Shipka Pass to the area known as The Valley of Roses. Stop at the top of the Shipka Pass to visit a monument built as a reminder of the heroic Shipka Pass battle that took place in 1878.

Continue onwards to the colourful Kazanlak Thracian Tomb, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Then in the afternoon, arrive in Plovdiv, one of the oldest cities in Europe.

Upon arrival enjoy an orientation of the Old Town and then enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Overnight: Hotel Alliance or similar, Plovdiv

## Meals included: Breakfast

## **Day 16 Plovdiv City Tour**

Today enjoy a guided tour of Plovdiv, the second largest city in Bulgaria. You will visit the town's landmarks and uncover its rich history. Start with a walk in the Old Town which is situated on 3 hills and is an architectural reserve with lovely examples of Bulgarian Renaissance architecture. You will visit Kîyumdzioglu House which houses the city's Ethnographic museum, then you will walk to the Roman Amphitheatre which is beautifully preserved and still used as the cultural heart of Plovdiv.

Continue with a walk down to the 14th century Djumaya Mosque and past the Roman Stadium in the middle of a pedestrian street. Enjoy the charming pedestrian street with more examples of 19th and 20th century houses, parks and fountains as well as lively cafes and cosy restaurants before returning to the hotel.

Overnight: Hotel Alliance or similar, Plovdiv Meals included: Breakfast

## Day 17 Plovdiv - Sofia

After breakfast check out and drive to Sofia, the capital of Bulgaria. Upon arrival in Sofia, enjoy a city tour including a panoramic sightseeing drive, a visit of the Boyana Church (a UNESCO World Heritage Site) and a walk that will explore the major sights Sofia has to offer including the Aleksandar Nevski Cathedral, the Parliament, the Russian church, the Presidential Palace and St. George's Rotunda.

Afterwards check into the hotel and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

## **Day 18 Rila Monastery Day Trip**

Today enjoy a day trip from Sofia to the UNESCO World Heritage listed Rila Monastery. Founded by the 10th-century patron saint of the Bulgarians, John of Rila, it's considered one of Bulgaria's holiest sites. This architectural masterpiece played an essential role in Bulgarian cultural preservation throughout the Middle Ages and well into the 19th century, when exquisite restoration work produced frescoes and icons by prominent masters

## Day 19 Sofia, Bulgaria - Australia

## **TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER**

## **Tour Guide:**

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction in which he or she is guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves the group at the end of the tour, they do not travel with the group.

## **Tour Leader:**

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides in each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however, they are not required to have specific knowledge on art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/ attraction once there and if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when particularly required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

#### **CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES**

Romania & Bulgaria have a temperatecontinental climate with moderate features which is characteristic for Central Europe. with hot summers, long, cold winters and very distinct seasons. Abundant snowfalls may occur throughout the country from December to mid-March, especially if you are in the mountainous areas of Romania or Bulgaria.
