Hospital Admissions and Visitation of the Sick

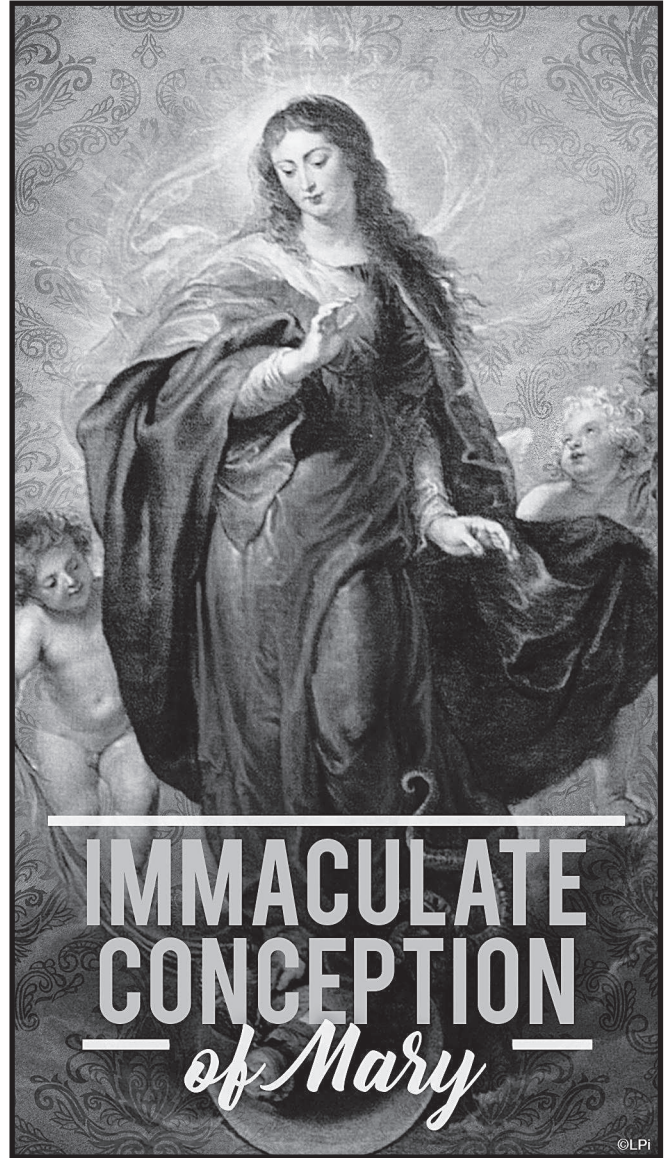
